Questions for the Bishop: As Bishop Alfred Schlert has been visiting parishes around the Diocese in the weeks following the release of the Grand Jury Report, many people have stayed to ask him questions. Now we're giving you the same opportunity, anyone with questions about the clergy sexual abuse issue is invited to email them to abusequestions@allentowndiocese.org. The Diocese will edit questions for clarity, length and appropriateness. Please include your name and hometown. On the website, we will identify questioners by their first name and hometown, unless you want that information withheld. We will not reveal your email address or last name.

Mandated Reporter Training: This Monday, November 12th at 5:30 p.m. in the church hall. **Please be advised** that the doors will be locked at 5:30 pm and late attendees will not be allowed to enter (this is a policy from the Diocese). A light supper will be provided. Saturday 6 PM Mass Suspended: For many reasons I find it necessary to suspend the 6PM Saturday Vigil Mass. First of all, few liturgical ministers have made themselves available for this Mass. We simply do not have any organists, lectors, Eucharistic ministers, ushers and servers who are willing to commit to the 6PM Liturgy and it is really not fair to expect the few who occasionally help out to serve at this Mass permanently. Secondly, although attendance reached a high of 70 this summer, it has consistently dropped over the last month from 50 on October 6th to 30 this past Saturday, November 3rd. I realize that eliminating this Mass will bring us back to a crowded 4PM Mass, both in the parking lot and in church. Unfortunately, St. Richard's is not large enough to accommodate the congregation at the 4PM Mass. (certainly, a "problem" many other churches would envy!) There is no solution to the issue that I can see—the absolute earliest Vigil Mass that can be celebrated on Saturday is 4PM, and an additional later Mass has not been viable. The only suggestion I have is to consider going to the 10:30AM Sunday Mass who's attendance hovers around 100 (the 8:30AM Mass is usually quite full). Given this situation, please don't leave your manners at home. No one should be "territorial" about "their" pew. Preference should be given to the elderly and parents with children, even if that means you'll have to stand for the Liturgy. Remember, Christ our Host would not have it any other way.
