Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are usually celebrated on a Sunday afternoon. Parents need to be registered parishioners and attend a Baptismal Preparation Class. At least one Godparent must be a practicing Catholic and obtain a Certificate of Eligibility from their parish.

Sponsor Eligibility

Certificates of Eligibility for Baptism and Confirmation require the sponsor to be a registered and active member of the parish, and if married, in a valid marriage recognized by the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Marriage

Arrangements should be made at least six months prior to the proposed wedding date to begin pre-nuptial instructions before making any arrangements. Please call the parish office for more information and to schedule an appointment with the Pastor.

TODAY'S LITURGY OF THE WORD: In the first reading, Abraham repeatedly intercedes for the people of Sodom and God says he will not destroy the city if there are even ten innocent people there. In the second reading, Paul writes that our transgressions have been forgiven by Jesus' sacrifice on the cross. In the Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples how to pray and tells them to be persistent in prayer. He assures them that the Father will give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him. All of Scripture tells us of the necessity of prayer, and Jesus exhorts us to be persistent because something powerful happens in repetitive prayer.

TODAY'S RESPONSORIAL PSALM: Lord, on the day I called for help, you answered me.
