

Mr. Yehuda Binder holds a B.Sc. (cum-laude) in Electronic Engineering from the Israeli Technion Institute of Technology, as well as an M.Sc.E.E. (cum-laude) and an M.B.A. from the Tel-Aviv University. Yehuda was Orckit's representative to the ETSI-TM6 and ANSI T1E1.4 standard committees, and took an active role in the actual drafting of the HDSL and ADSL standards, for both European and North-American markets.

Yehuda is an U.S. Patent Agent, and named on over 200 (!!) issued US patents, and over 250 patents worldwide. Most of the patents were sold in multiple transactions, and many were successfully litigated in the U.S., and Yehuda is considered an expert in patent monetization.

Yehuda was involved in many successful Israeli start ups, such as Orckit Communication (IPO-ed in Nasdaq) and Indigo (bought by HP), and also solely founded and managed SercoNet Ltd. The total investments in Yehuda's founded start-ups exceeded \$30M, and the investors typically enjoyed substantial return on their investments.
