

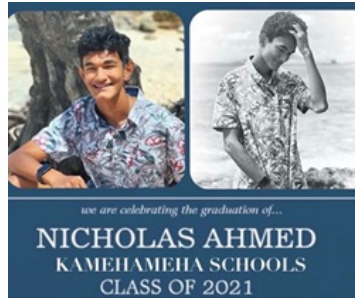

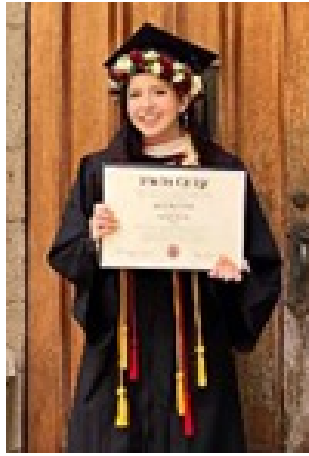

Going on vacation?

Are you going to be away for over four days? You would feel more secure if someone was watching your house. Have Ewa by Gentry Community Watch Team watch your house while you are away. This is a service included in your Ewa by Gentry Association fee. From the Ewa by Gentry Community Watch Team webpage.

"CWT will conduct "RESIDENCE CHECKS" at the request of the homeowner when the residence is vacant for more than four consecutive days. A homeowner need only fill out this online request. Once the form is received CWT will contact the homeowner to verify the information.

CWT will conduct an exterior inspection of the premises to assure that it is secure. In the event of a mishap of any nature, we will contact you and the appropriate authorities, and prepare reports as required.

You must be a full time resident of the Ewa by Gentry Community Association in Hawaii and physically residing in your home on a full time basis to use this service.
