Entry Kiosk

Use only your 3 digit code, the # symbol is no longer needed and will not work if used.

As we continue to work out the kinks with our new system, we know some homeowners and residents are still having issues allowing guest access. After much research and many phone calls, it appears that the tones (DTMF) coming from the cell phones are not transmitting to the gate because the tone is too short. This was a similar issue with the old system. I have found many great troubleshooting ideas, however each phone and carrier will be different. If you need assistance please email the office the problem you are having, the type of phone you are using and the carrier.

Pool & Furniture

The following are prohibited in the pool and deck area: glass containers, running, horseplay, gum chewing, water guns, noodles, large flotation devices such as rafts, rubber boats, and boogie boards. Diving or jumping into the pool and excessive noise is also prohibited. Swimmers must dry off completely before entering the Clubhouse, upstairs lanai, or exercise room. **All deck chairs and other furniture that has been moved must be returned to its original position. For example, lounge chairs should be side-by-side with backs 3/4 upright.**

Fitness Center

The use of equipment is on a "first come, first served" basis. However, courtesy to others should be extended when others are waiting. When finished with a piece of equipment, users should wipe it clean.

Please turn off TV and lights when you exit if you are the last user in the fitness facility.
