The Board of Directors have prioritized budgeted items and developed a plan to begin upgrading many of the common area amenities that you enjoy.

Completed Projects in 2020:

- Fitness Center AC Repaired
- Phase 4 Painting (20 Homes)
- Spa Light was replaced
- Pool deck coating was removed
- Concrete repairs were made around the pool and spa
- 2 Light Poles replaced
- Added accent rocks around pool area
- Repaired some lighting around the pool deck
- Performed the annual backflow testing
- Inspected and Painted Fire Hydrant
- Asphalt Repairs/Sealcoating
- Common Area Tree Trimming
- Repaired 2 Water Line Leaks

Safety

- 1. Due to the increase in outdoor activities, we wanted to remind our residents and guests to slow down and obey the posted **5 mph speed limit** and directional signs to help ensure the safety of our residents and guests while doing so.
- 2. We want to remind parents of our community that it's a Hawaii state law that "No person under sixteen years of age shall operate a bicycle upon a street, bikeway, or any other public property unless that person is wearing a properly fitted and fastened bicycle helmet that has been tested by a nationally recognized agency such as the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the National Safety Council, or the Children's Safety Network, and is designed to fit the user and protect against head trauma."
- 3. Please ensure your children are safely riding their bicycles and are looking both ways prior to riding out of driveways. Riding bicycles at night can be dangerous for children. If your children ride bicycles at night, we recommend having reflectors, bike lights, and wear reflective clothing to ensure a motorist can see them riding. The Board of Directors number one concern is for the safety of our residents and their children!

Guidelines for Opening Pool/Spa – Effective September 24th 2020

The CDC guidance, under all circumstances, the following precautions should be followed by people utilizing pools. To the extent possible, these providers should take measures to ensure that customers may follow these guidelines:

• Maintain physical social distancing, to the extent possible. Masks are required unless you are actively swimming. We ask parents to consider if their children are capable of staying at least 6 feet apart from people they don't live with before taking them to the pool.

• No more than 5 persons will be allowed in the swimming pool/area at one time. Only 1 person/family allowed in the spa at a time. Only residents that are already registered with the office will be allowed, NO GUESTS at this time. Reservations are not needed so please have your access card to enter the gate.

- Please limit your time in the pool to one hour, to allow others the opportunity to use the pool.
- The shower area will be open, please shower prior to entering the pool.
- Chairs and tables will be limited for use.

• Due to space limitations toys and floats will not be permitted at this time; the pool is opening for swimming/exercise purposes only.

• Disinfectants and hand sanitizer are available to the left of the gate when exiting the pool area; please use the disinfectants to wipe your chair before and after use.

• Hours of operation will be daily 6AM-1000PM. Please abide by the guidelines set forth, so we can continue to keep the amenities open.

Fitness Room Opening Guidelines – Effective September 7th 2020

The BOD have decided to extend the hours for the fitness center, effective Monday September 7th. The new hours will be 4AM-10PM and the below guidelines will still be in place. Reservations will be offered every hour on the hour, this means that your workout and cleanup must be completed within 60 minute time slots. Please be mindful of your time, we do not want you to run over into the next person's reservation. The first reservation available will be at 4AM and the last being at 9PM.

Following the CDC guidance, under all circumstances, the following precautions should be followed by people utilizing Fitness Centers. To the extent possible, these providers should take measures to ensure that customers may follow these guidelines:

• Maintain physical social distancing, to the extent possible, face masks are required walking in and out of the fitness center.

• Only 1 person will be allowed in the fitness room at one time unless you are from the same household the limit will be 3 persons. NO GUESTS at this time.

• The time limit will be one hour and please wipe down the equipment you will be using with the disinfectant spray provided before and after use of equipment.

• The fitness center will be open daily 4AM-10PM, reservations required. You will be entering the fitness center at your own risk.

We all must abide by the guidelines set forth so we can continue to open the amenities.
