LOGLINE

When love turns into control and empathy becomes captivity, “TOXIC” uncovers the hidden psychological battles between narcissists, empaths, and the trauma that binds them.

SERIES OVERVIEW

TOXIC is a televised docudrama that explores the emotional and psychological world of narcissistic personality disorder, borderline personality disorder, and trauma bonding. Through expert insights, survivor stories, and dramatic reenactments, the series reveals how charm, manipulation, and dependency evolve into emotional captivity.

Each 53-minute episode follows a character-driven narrative anchored by one or two central individuals such as a survivor, a self-aware narcissist, or an expert with a personal story. Their experiences bring psychology to life and transform complex concepts into intimate human drama. A continuing redemptive storyline follows one survivor’s journey toward recovery, giving the season emotional depth and a strong sense of continuity.

FORMAT AND TONE

- **Genre:** Psychological Documentary and Docudrama
- **Structure:** 7 episodes, 53 minutes each
- **Style:** Intimate, investigative, and emotionally charged, blending documentary realism with cinematic storytelling.
- **Tone References:** *The Vow* (HBO), *Dirty John* (Bravo/Netflix), *The Tinder Swindler* (Netflix), *Stutz* (Netflix).
- **Visual Identity:** Cinematic realism with stylized lighting, layered sound design, and symbolic imagery such as mirrors and reflections that express fractured identity. Voiceovers from survivors and subjects are interwoven with reenactments to create emotional immersion.

EPISODE ARC (SEASON 1)

1. **Charm and Control** – The creation of attraction and deception.
2. **The Empath Trap** – Why compassionate people are drawn to toxic partners.
3. **Gaslight Nation** – The manipulation of truth and the breakdown of identity.
4. **Borderline Lines** – The collision between love, fear, and abandonment.
5. **Trauma Bonds** – How pain masquerades as love and why it is hard to leave.
6. **Mirror, Mirror** – Conversations with narcissists and the ego beneath the mask.
7. **Breaking Free** – Recovery, self-awareness, and the rebuilding of personal identity.

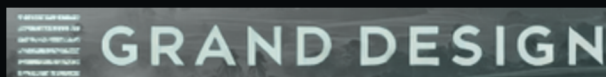
TARGET AUDIENCE
