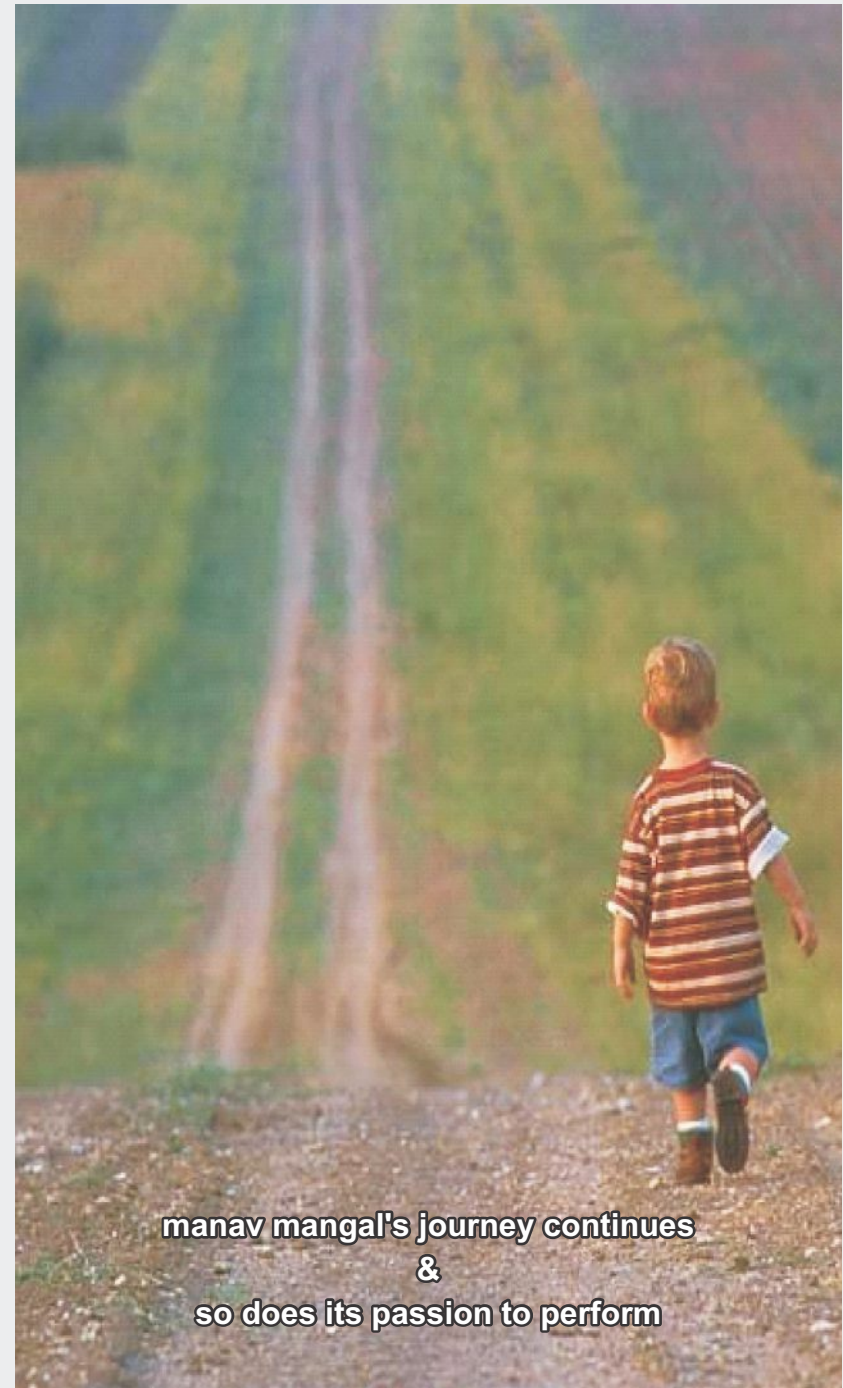
- a) TechSmart Classroom Learning

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADMISSION

- ◆ Application for admission should be made on the prescribed form by the parents of the student. In absence of any genuine ground to be placed on record, both the parents are required to put their signatures on application for admission to school.
- ◆ a) The parents of a first time admission - seeker will submit the date of birth certificate issued by the Registrar of Births.
- ◆ b) In the case of a student coming on transfer from a school, the parents will submit
 - i) date of birth certificate issued by the Registrar of Births
 - ii) student's transfer certificate
 - iii) his / her progress report for the past academic session
 - iv) copy of Aadhaar Card.

PAYMENT OF SCHOOL FEES

- ◆ School fees can be paid
 - a) Online through School Mobile App by using Credit Card / Debit Card / Net Banking or
 - b) Offline at School Fee Counter by Credit Card / Debit Card on Card Swipe Machine (POS) / UPI or
 - c) Offline at School Fee Counter by Account Payee Cheque drawn in favour of 'manav mangal high school'.
- ◆ School fee is to be paid between 1st and 10th of every month. However, fee for May and June is to be deposited by 10th of May and fee for February and March by 10th of February.
- ◆ In case monthly fees are not paid by 10th, the parent will make payment of dues between 11th and 25th of the month with a fine of Rs. 25 per day of delay.
- ◆ If dues are not paid by 25th of the month, the defaulter's name will be removed from the rolls on 26th without any notice.
- ◆ For getting the student re-admitted latest by the month end, the parent will arrange to deposit arrears of fee and other charges along with a Re-admission fee of Rs. 500.
- ◆ In case cheque issued by the parent is returned unpaid for any reason, he will arrange to deposit the payable amount along with a penalty of Rs. 150 **at the school fee collection counter by cash only.**
- ◆ Fees once paid are not refundable on any account either in full or in part.
- ◆ School can increase fees and other charges by 8 % from the start of the new academic session.



TRANSPORT SERVICE

- ◆ The school office has the standing instructions to help in arranging transport service as and when required but it is in no way obligatory for the office to answer demand for transport service.
- ◆ When Bus/Rickshaw goes out of order or when its driver/puller is not available for service especially on health ground, it becomes parent's responsibility to send his son/daughter to school and take him/her back home. In such cases, no claim will be entertained.
- ◆ A parent wishing to withdraw his son/daughter from availing the transport facility must inform the concerned quarters through the school office in writing by the last day of the month for which the transport charges have been paid failing which the parent will pay transport charges for the following month.

WITHDRAWAL

- ◆ A parent wishing to withdraw his son/daughter from school must inform the school office in writing by the last day of the month for which the fee has been paid failing which fee for the following month will have to be paid.
- ◆ Security amount is refunded if the student is to pay no dues on leaving the school. Dues if any, are adjusted out of the security amount and balance refunded online through bank transfer or through an A/C Payee cheque drawn in favour of the parent.
- ◆ Refund of security amount, if due, can be claimed within three months of student's leaving the school.

GENERAL

- ◆ A student coming late to school has to submit his/her parent's duly signed written note giving cause of late coming.
- ◆ Students are not permitted to get back home during school working hours. In case of any emergency, only a parent can come personally and take his / her child along on seeking Principal's permission in writing.
- ◆ In case, the school office gives a call to the parent to take his ward back home on health ground, it is the parent who will come personally, find out detail of ward's health problem and take him/her back home.
- ◆ Every parent should see that his son/daughter applies for leave and gets it sanctioned before absenting himself/herself from the school. Leave application must invariably be signed by the parent to confirm his consent.



- ◆ On student's continuous absence without leave for six working days, his/her name is struck off the school rolls without any notice. It is, on submitting satisfactory explanation alongwith payment of Re-admission fee of Rs. 500 that the student's name may be put back to rolls.
- ◆ Library books have got to be returned in time for further circulation. Fine per day of late return of a Library book is Rs.5.
- ◆ Home work is assigned through the Daily Diary. Every parent should see that it is completed by his son/daughter. Not only that : the Student's Daily Diary which is a link between the teacher and parent must be seen and signed daily by the parent.
- ◆ A parent is to see that his son/daughter comes to school everyday in proper and full uniform. Girl students are not allowed to let their nails grow or use nail polish.
- ◆ A parent is to see a teacher on the day fixed for Parent-Teacher Meeting during the fixed interview hours. A teacher is not to be disturbed while he/she is meeting a class.
- ◆ A teacher should not be criticized in the presence of his/her student. It undermines student's respect for the teacher and weakens his/her willingness to learn from that teacher.
- ◆ Any change of address/telephone number should be communicated to the school office without delay. It saves inconvenience/ complication especially in an hour of emergency.
- ◆ A student suffering from contagious or infectious disease should not be sent to school till he/she fully recovers from it. It is on getting certificate of fitness from the school doctor that he / she can start attending classes again.
- ◆ Apart from school's listed holidays, the school also observes holidays declared by the U.T. Administration from time to time. Children should not be sent to school on such declared holidays.
- ◆ The school cannot be held responsible for any accidental or inadvertent injury to any student.
- ◆ The Principal reserves the right to remove from the school any student whose bad conduct is an unhealthy precedent for others.
- ◆ Preference will be given to the students wanting to migrate from one branch of manav mangal Group of Schools to another. However this would be possible only
 - a) Before the start of new academic session and
 - b) If the requested seat is available in the branch where the student wishes to migrate.

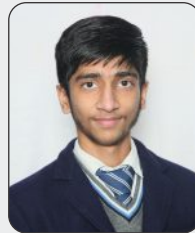

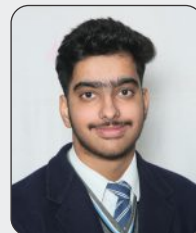

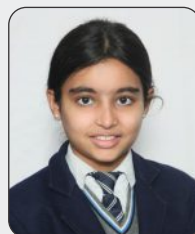
