TETBURY CRICKET CLUB MEMBERSHIP OPTIONS





Tetbury Cricket Club has a long and proud history dating back to 1850. One of the first clubs to be established in the county, the club has previously produced both county and England international players, and our upcoming season offers the opportunity to be one of the most exciting in living memory.

Over the last few years we have worked hard to create an inclusive community atmosphere and diversify to offer everyone the chance to participate in the great game that is cricket. Our community efforts have also been recently recognised with the club achieving charity status.

Looking ahead to 2024, we'll be running four Saturday men's teams, two ladies teams covering both hardball and softball, two midweek sides, a veterans team and youth teams, for both boys and girls, from 6 through to Under 15's.

Our ethos at Tetbury CC centres around giving everyone the opportunity to play cricket, from those who've never picked up a cricket bat before, through to those ultimate cricket badgers! That means no matter what your ability or experience, our doors are open and we'd love for you to come and get involved.

As a member of Tetbury CC you have access to a range of benefits:

- Eligible for selection within our range of teams
- Discounted club kit
- Use of training facilities and equipment when not being used for organised club activities
- Membership of the Member's Bar and access to special offers
- Discounted prices to some of our community and fundraising events
- Entitlement to put yourself forward for an active role in the running of your Club
- Insurance cover when taking place in organised club activities
- Access to special offers from some of our sponsors
- Voting rights at the AGM



The club is aware of the pressures everyone is facing with the cost of living crisis and have seen this ourselves with the rising costs of running the club. We remain committed though to ensuring cricket remains affordable and accessible so we are again freezing membership prices, meaning they have not increased by a single penny in the last six seasons.

That means our membership options are:

Seniors Membership - £30 (PAYG) or £150 (All In)

Ladies Membership - £30 (PAYG)

Veterans Membership - £30 (PAYG)

Youth Membership - £65 (All In)

Vice Presidents Membership - £30 (individual) or £50 (couple)

Volunteer Membership - £ 12 (individual) or £ 20 (couple)

The 'fine print' of your membership:

- Your membership runs from 1st April to 31st March.
- · All memberships must be paid in full by 1st May to be available for selection in club fixtures
- All In memberships cover all costs of memberships, meaning you do not pay match fees for weekend games and your only additional costs
 during the season will be on friendly or midweek fixtures or attendance at any of our community or fundraising events.
- PAYG membership means a match fee is payable each time you play, either competitive or friendly cricket. For seniors this is £10, for ladies this
 is £5, for veterans this is £5 or £10 depending on the type of match.
- Vice President membership is for non-playing executive members and will include invitations to certain club events
- Volunteer membership is for non-playing members who wish to be associated with the club and help through volunteering
- All playing members are required to purchase a training and playing top to wear when representing Tetbury CC.
- · All In Youth Memberships cover individuals for representing youth teams. Match fees are payable for any games played in adult cricket.







As we've already noted, the club is mindful of ensuring everyone has the opportunity to participate in our activities and are working hard to ensure no one is excluded because of the prices associated in playing cricket. The trustees are therefore taking the following steps:

- 1) We are again offering the ability to phase your membership payments, so the fee is payable in more affordable segments. This gives you the opportunity to pay in installments in the lead up to the start of the season in May. If you'd like to arrange this, contact Jamie Ponting (jamie.ponting@tetburycc.co.uk)
- 2) We will provide any of the equipment you need to either train for or play a game of cricket. Whether that is a helmet, some pads or some gloves, we've got you covered! During the winter, the trustees have invested in a range of new equipment meaning we now have enough for all our teams. There is absolutely no need for anyone in any of our teams to buy any cricket equipment prior to joining.
- 3) Throughout 2024 we are committed to researching more about our membership structure and how members feel this should evolve in the coming years, as we want to make sure the options and payment structure works for you. As an example, we're mindful we now have more families playing cricket than ever before, so should we have a family membership? Team Managers will speak to you all about this over the season and you'll also see a club survey being shared.
- 4) In 2024 we will continue to provide members with access to the 'Tetbury CC Participation Fund' which is a ring-fenced pot of money available for any members who are finding the costs of taking part a little bit tough to manage.
