

Silly Sounds Articulation Adventure!

/S/ SOUND PRODUCTION WORKSHEETS

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Instructions:

Welcome, young explorer! Today, we're going on an adventure with sounds. Let's practice saying some words and make sure our sounds are as clear as possible. Remember to take your time and have fun!

1. The /s/ Sound Practice

- Say each word slowly three times:

- Sun: (suh-n) - "The sun is bright!"

- Snake: (sss-nay-k) - "A snake slithers in the grass."

- Sand: (sss-and) - "I love playing in the sand."

- **Draw It!**

- Draw a picture of something that starts with the /s/ sound. Can you draw a star or sock?

2. Tongue Twister Fun!

- Repeat this silly sentence five times without laughing:

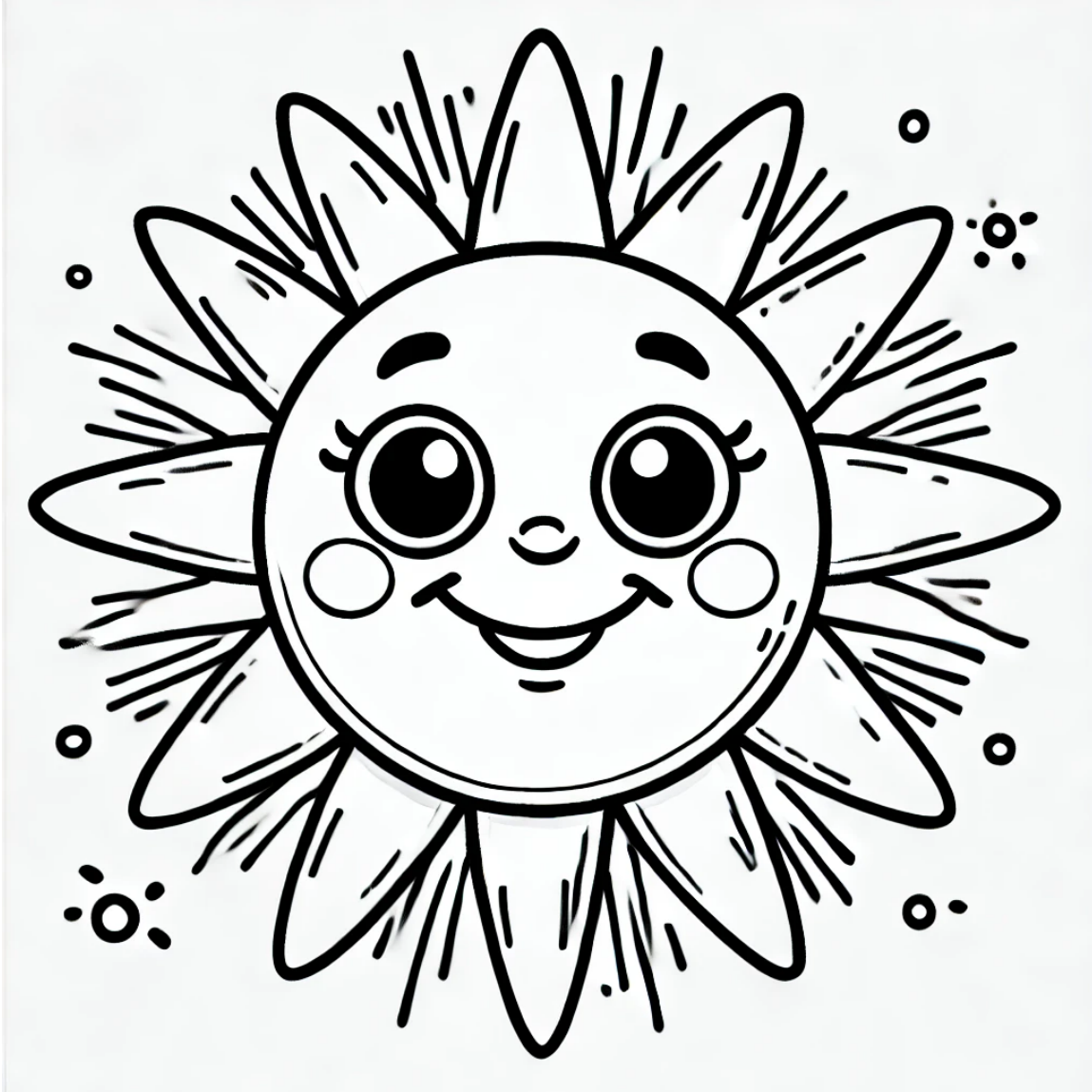
- "Seven slippery snakes slide silently."

Take your time and say it as clearly as possible!

3. Color and Say

- Below are some pictures of things with the /s/ sound. Color them and say each word three times:

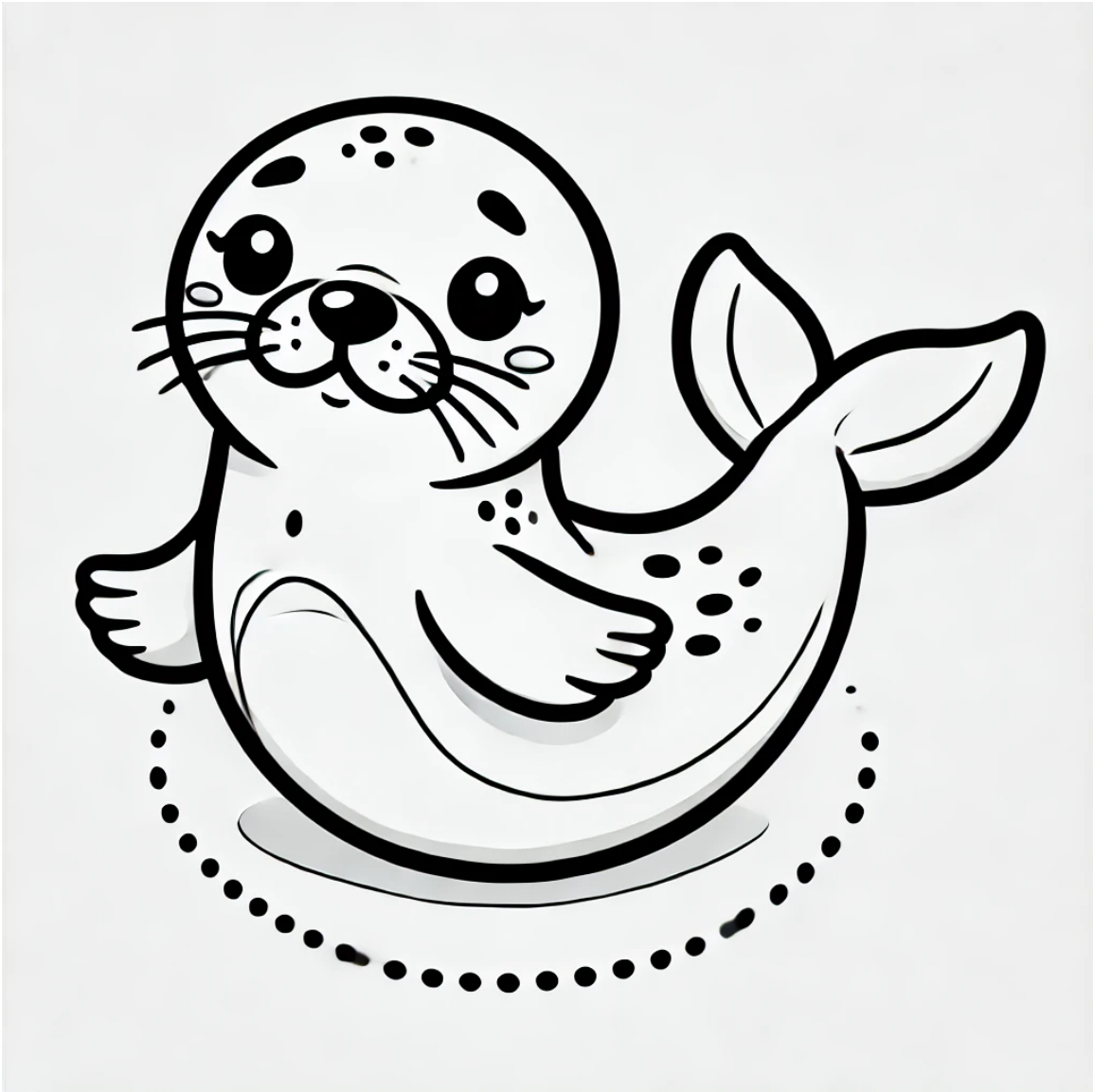
- Sun

- Words: sandwich, soap, socks, seal

- Example: "The seal wore socks while eating a sandwich covered in soap!"

- Look around the room. Can you find three things that have the /s/ sound? Write them down or draw them below!

- Try to teach a family member or friend how to say these words clearly. You're the teacher now!
