

SCRIPTURE CAKE

(A Bible Riddle Recipe)

1	cup	Judges, Chapter 5, Verse 25 (last clause)
1	cup	Jeremiah, Chapter 6, Verse 20
1	tablespoon	I Samuel, Chapter 14, Verse 25
3	whole	Jeremiah, Chapter 17, Verse 11
1	cup	II Samuel, Chapter 16, Verse 1 (second food)
1	cup, chopped	Nahum, Chapter 3, Verse 12
¼	cup, blanched and chopped	Numbers, Chapter 17, Verse 8
2	cups	I Kings, Chapter 4, Verse 22 (first food)
1	teaspoon	Proverbs, Chapter 7, Verse 17 (last word)
½	teaspoon	Leviticus, Chapter 2, Verse 13
1	teaspoon	Amos, Chapter 4, Verse 5
3	tablespoons	Judges, Chapter 4, Verse 19 (last sentence)

Cream first 3 ingredients. Beat in 3 Jeremiahs, one at a time. Stir in next 3 ingredients and beat again. Sift together Kings, II Chronicles, Leviticus, and Amos. Add to first mixture and blend well. Lastly, beat in Judges.

Bake in a 325° F. oven in greased and floured tube pan for 1 hour, or until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 5 minutes in pan before turning out onto serving plate to cool completely.

GLAZE:

1/3	cup, powdered	Jeremiah, Chapter 6, Verse 20
1-2	teaspoons	Judges, Chapter 4, Verse 19 (last sentence)

Blend together and drizzle over warm cake.

Hint: The “leaven” which works best is baking powder.
