



## ALABAMA STATE LECTURESHIP FOR THE CHURCHES OF CHRIST GOVERNING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR VENDOR BOOTHS

1. One (8) foot table, and one chair.
2. The AL State Lectureship Committee reserves the right to cancel any contract if there is a conflict with the ethics of the AL State Lectureship.
3. There is absolutely NO space for exhibitors outside the official vendor area. No roving entertainment or advertisement will be allowed.
4. Posting and/or distribution of literature samples or souvenirs is permitted from the contracted space only!
5. No Food or Drink can be sold.
6. **RECORDINGS IN ANY MEDIUM OF CONVENTION PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES, PAST AND PRESENT, ARE NOT TO BE SOLD WITHOUT THE WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION OF THE LECTURESHIP CHAIRMAN.**
7. **NO** exhibitor shall assign, sublet or share the whole or part of the booth space allotted. The exhibitor agrees for himself and his employees to use contracted space for lawful purposes only and will conform to all laws, ordinances, and regulations.
8. **WARNING TO ALL VENDORS WITH SOUND: ALL VENDORS ARE SUBJECT TO SOUND LEVEL STANDARDS THAT WILL BE SET BY THE VENDORS COMMITTEE; IF YOUR SOUND LEVELS EXCEED THAT WHICH THE VENDOR COMMITTEE SETS, YOU WILL BE GIVEN A WARNING AND ASKED TO LOWER THE VOLUME. IF A SECOND REQUEST BECOMES NECESSARY, YOU WILL BE ESCORTED OUT OF THE VENDOR ROOM AND PROHIBITED FROM EXHIBITING.**
9. The Lectureship, its agents and employees are not liable for damages to or for theft/loss or destruction of the exhibitor's property or injuries to the exhibitor, his representative, agents or employees. All claims for any such theft/loss, damage, destruction or injury are expressly waived by the exhibitor. The Lectureship will also be exempted from or indemnified for any claims or injury to any of the exhibitor's representatives, agents or employees.
10. The Lectureship, its agents and employees will not be liable for failure to hold the event as scheduled. Payment for booth space will be returned in that event, except for reason of fire, or any act of God or the public enemy, or strike, or epidemic, or any law or regulation of public authority, or any cause beyond the control of the Lectureship which makes it impossible or impractical to hold the event.
11. Be advised that exhibitors may be liable for a sales tax and may be contacted by the State Department of Finance, Revenue, sales and Use Tax.
12. Persons violating these rules and regulations will be asked to leave the premises without a refund. Please read carefully. Your signature on this form and the application is a binding agreement to these rules and regulations.
