- When asked why, the suspect says somebody about hurting his family and they wanted him to hurt kids. He then says he can't do that, so he "has to do this" and pulls out a gun.
- The Sergeant responds by telling Mitchell multiple times to put the weapon down as he draws his gun.
- Suspect dead Sergeant severely wounded.
