

Master Small Prayer Group Protocol

8.22.20

Praise the Lord regarding the Ephesians prayer, the Name of Jesus, or any Biblical promise.

Pray the Ephesians prayer over yourselves REGARDING THE SUBJECT OR PERSON YOU ARE PRAYING ABOUT.

Leader prays Ephesians prayer and then prays in English as far as they can. Follower keeps their voice lifted in tongues through all this. Follower purposing to agree from the heart.

THEN DEFER BACK AND FORTH - pray both in English and in tongues. Deferred means each other takes turns praying.

Pray for 20 - 30 minutes this way - deferring.

At 20 til - leader starts thanking the Father for what you have just prayed and for the utterances He granted.

Share what you got.

Write down what you got.

Date it. Write down syllables that stand out, scriptures that came up, things you heard other person say - whether they heard it or not. Record thoughts and ideas. Draw pictures if you saw pictures. Record colors and details, etc.

Reshelve journal.

End at top of the hour. Formally dismiss.

***No matter what, formally end prayer session at the top of the hour.**

- *No personal prophecies or prophesying to each other in the group.
- *No laying on of hands with other members of the group.
- *Journals do not go home with the prayers.
- *Practice deferring and seeing WHO has the ball.
- *When praying 20 - 30 minutes, its great to go back in forth in English and in tongues.
- *Sometimes the closer you get physically or in proximity the stronger the anointing gets.
- *If you feel that you have a prophecy for another member of the group, please follow this instruction. **WAIT to give it until AFTER FORMAL DISMISSAL OF SESSION AND AFTER EXITING THE ASSIGNED PHYSICAL PREMISES.**

When praying with other people at times you may pick up on things about those people - perhaps good, perhaps bad. No matter what you pick up or sense about your prayer partner - it is always good to adhere and live by the golden rule:

Do not say anything to them about it unless you have strong,definite UNCTION to do so.
