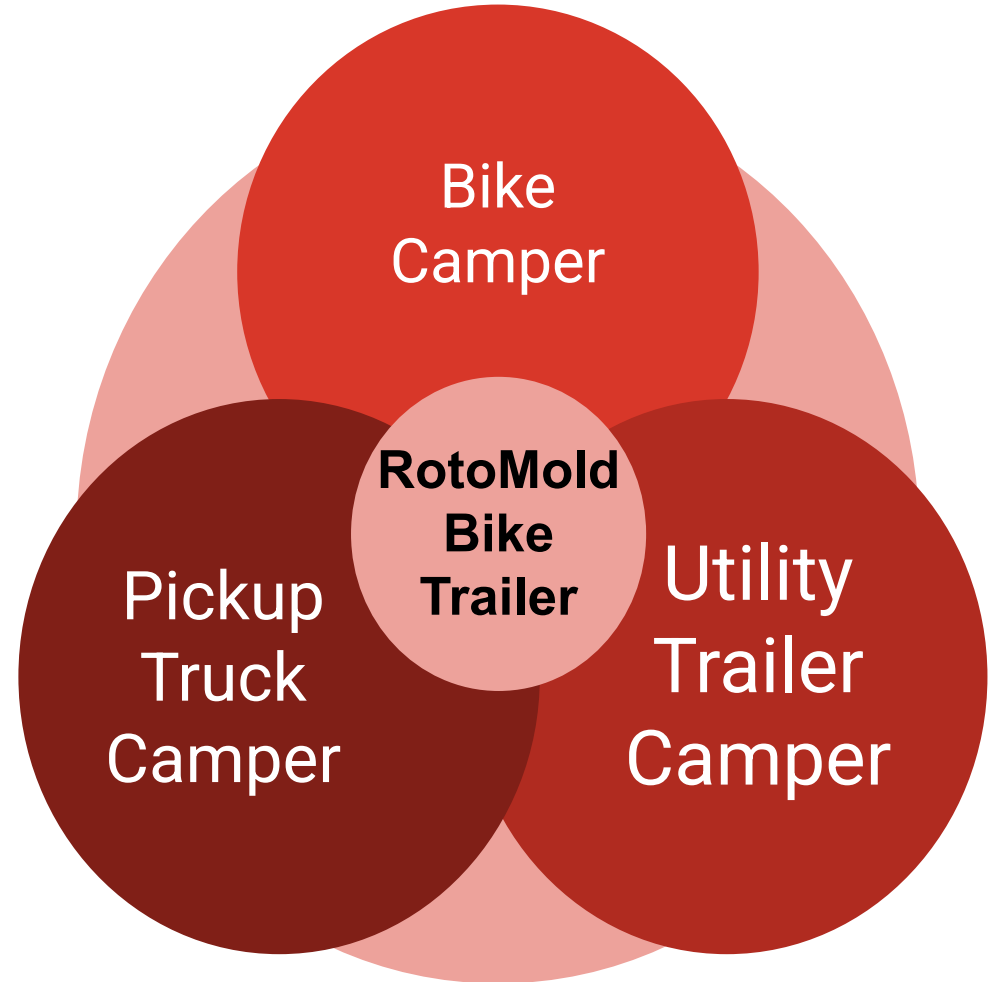

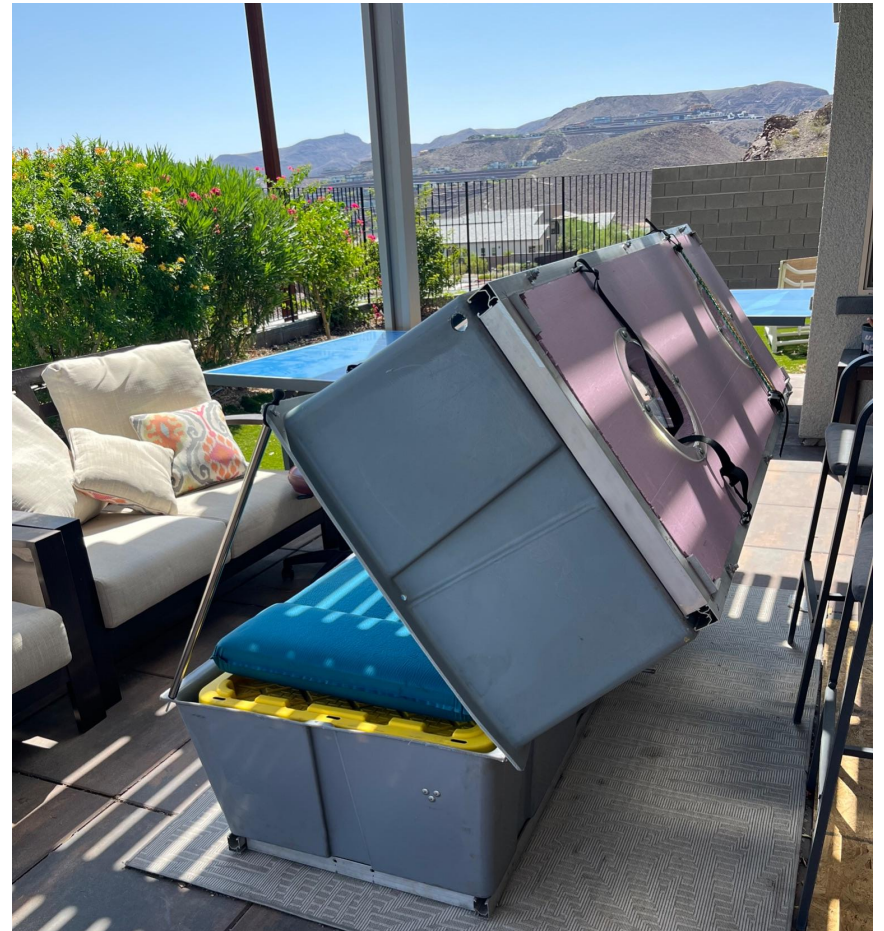


Expedition 4.0 Hardtop Camper

2024 Supreme Court Ruling & the Dismantling of Encampments

- HUD CoC (Brick and Mortar): “Housing is a Human Right”
- Shelters (No privacy, No ownership, & Violence).
- Sanctioned Encampments: Provide everyone their own bed, their own storage, and access to bathrooms/other services.
- Wondering the streets/sleeping on the ground.

Bottom Line: “We need new solutions for interim housing”

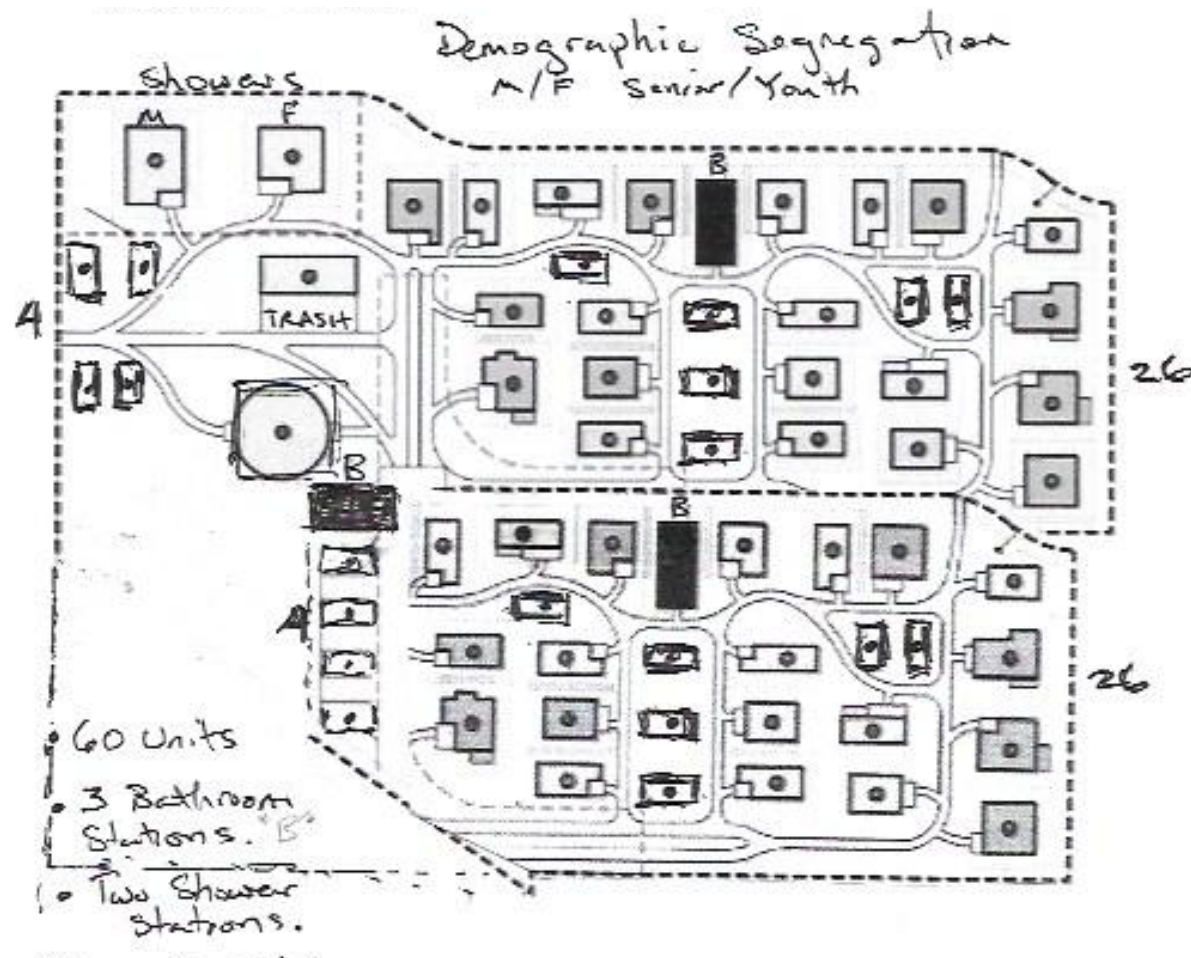
