



INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 2 Nights' accommodation at the Holiday Inn, Port Moresby.
- Airport Transfers between Hotel and Airport (Collected at the Airport by Koiari Trekking Staff)
- Transfer from Hotel to Airfield for travel to or from the track (dependent upon the direction of travel)
- Charter Flight between Port Moresby and Kokoda (or Kokoda to POM relating to the direction of travel for your trek)
- All Track Licence Fees
- 20 million in Public Liability
- All accommodation on the track at the most spectacular villages including use of a company tent.
- All meals on the Track (Breakfast, Morning Tea, Lunch, Afternoon Tea and Dinner). This is supplemented with fresh fruit and vegetables purchased along the track from Villages.
- All historical sites are visited (Most companies only take you to two, we take you to eight)
- Memorial Services at Brigade Hill and Isurava Battle Fields
- General Porters to carry our food, safety equipment and specialist stores (Machete's, axes, safety Ropes etc)
- A traditional Koiari man as your guide. This man is a direct descendant to the Fuzzy Wuzzy Angels and will detail to you the stories of his forefathers as told to him. He will take you to the places and the sites of significance and show you Kokoda through the eyes of the Fuzzy Wuzzy.
- A thorough medical evacuation plan with Satellite Phone Communications back to our office. This plan details three levels of priority from: Priority 1: Where death is imminent within 12 hours (Spinal, Head wound, arterial bleeding, cardiac event). Priority 2: Where there is no fear of death within 48 Hours and a patient can be moved (Fracture, Dislocation, non-arterial wound etc). Priority 3: are injuries like small scrapes and abrasions that can be dealt with using personal medical stores.
- Visits to Bomana War Cemetery at the completion of the Trek when walking from Kokoda to Owers Corner and both before and after the trek when travelling Owers Corner to Kokoda.

WHATS NOT INCLUDED

- Food and beverages at the Hotel.
- Personal Porter Fee. (This is an \$500 fee, this is a contract between you and him, facilitated by us)
- Individual snacks purchased along the track at various village markets.
- Souvenirs purchased at various village markets.
- International Flights from Australia to Port Moresby (Historically trekkers prefer to do this themselves to obtain the best price and time of flight to suit their life and budget)
- Personal Travel Insurance We apologise but legally we cannot tell you provider to choose, you
 must research this yourself, but we recommend you choose a provider which allows for helicopter
 medical evacuation back to Australia.
- PNG Tourist Visa (\$50USD) purchased online prior to trekking.
- Provision of Personal Medical Stores.
