Notes on using our new aluminium cassettes.

1. They will hold 36 exposures with the LX recessed feed cap. More than 36 exposures may damage the cassette or the camera.
2. Additional tape is recommended to seal the caps together. 6mm yellow Tamyra modelling tape is ideal. VEF Minox and II models are much tighter than later models. Atarons fit the best.

3. The parts are not designed to fit modern Minox cassettes (from Minocolor II onwards). Earlier cassettes – 1938-1968 are compatible.
4. We can supply replacement inner felt to special order
5. We can engrave the cassettes and the boxes with serial and identification data soon. A UID sticker is provided with each film to keep a database.
6. The cassettes cannot be accidentally damaged.
7. Be careful when fitting a cassette inside the camera that you have not left a bottom cap behind. These are not easy to see, especially in a VEF Minox.
