### Trash, Recycling and Yard Waste Collection

### New Service Provider – Effective January 2, 2026

Republic Services will continue providing residential curbside collection through December 31, 2025. There will be no service on January 1, 2026, due to the New Year's Day holiday. Beginning January 2, 2026, residential curbside collection will be provided by Coastal Waste & Recycling. We ask residents to please be patient during this transition, as it occurs during the busy holiday season.

**Holiday Closures** - All Solid Waste Facilities will be closed and there will be NO trash, recycling or yard waste collection on the following holidays:

- Christmas Day, Thursday, December 25, 2025
- New Year's Day, Thursday, January 1, 2026

**Holiday Collection Schedule** - Collection will occur on your next *regularly scheduled* service date as follows:

- Christmas **trash** will be picked up on Monday, December 29, 2025 by Republic Services
- New Year's **trash** will be picked up on Monday, January 5, 2026 by Coastal Waste
- Christmas and New Year's **recycling and yard waste** will be picked up on Thursday, January 8, 2026 by Coastal Waste

### What to expect on collection days after the holidays:

Due to the increased volume of trash and recycling following a holiday, your service provider will be working extra hard to ensure that all

customers are picked up. Please follow the guidelines below and expect the following conditions to occur:

- **Trash limits still apply.** Only material inside the blue cart with lid closed will be collected. Overfull carts and extra bags placed outside the cart will not be picked up. (See drop-off options below for excess material or consider enrolling in curbside recycling to free up cart space.)
- Collection may occur **earlier or later than usual**. Please place items at the curb **before 6 a.m.** Trucks may run later than normal.
- **Extra trucks** may be in service and may differ from your usual truck type. Ensure your cart is placed with arrows facing the street, five feet from other objects, and with no overhead obstructions.

**Holiday delays may affect the entire week.** If pickup is delayed, it may shift service days for the remainder of the week. Missed pickups will

be completed the next business day. Please wait until 10 a.m. the following morning before reporting a missed pickup.

**Drop Off Available:** Although Solid Waste Facilities are closed on holidays, they will be open during normal business hours for the rest of the week for disposal of excess trash, recycling, or yard waste.

**Holiday Schedule (No Service/Landfill Closed):** Thanksgiving, Christmas Day, New Year's Day, Independence Day

**Christmas tree disposal:**

- **Live trees:** May be placed out on your yard waste collection day if cut into pieces under 4 feet and free of decorations, including tinsel
- **Artificial trees:** Segments under 4 feet may be disposed of as a free bulk item by calling to schedule pickup

**Safe Fireworks Disposal:** Fireworks that are not fully extinguished can create a serious fire hazard when placed in garbage containers. Garbage truck and landfill fires can become life-threatening, cause severe injuries to employees, damage vehicles or nearby buildings, and harm the environment and wildlife. To safely dispose of fireworks:

1. **Submerge** fireworks in a bucket of water overnight to ensure they are fully extinguished.

2. **Wrap** the soaked fireworks in two plastic bags to keep them from drying out.


































**Place** the double-bagged fireworks in your household garbage.

**Fireworks are not recyclable and should never be placed in your recycling container.**
