This agenda item presents the legal documentation to execute the funds necessary to resurface Shoal Line Blvd from Caliente to Jewfish Drive – it does not include the Caliente Storm Water Drainage project. Government Affairs Committee Update for May 2024. Between now and November will be an exciting time for Hernando County Voters. The August Primary is the time we elect our Board of County Commissioners (BOCC), narrow down the list of School Board Members, elect our Circuit Court Judge, Sheriff, Property Appraiser and Tax Collector. The Clerk of Courts is currently unopposed. According to sources in the County Administration progress is being made to rebuild the network infrastructure that was subject to a ransom ware attack. Florida law does not allow government agencies to pay ransom for such attacks. A big shout out to the membership and board for a very successful candidates forum.

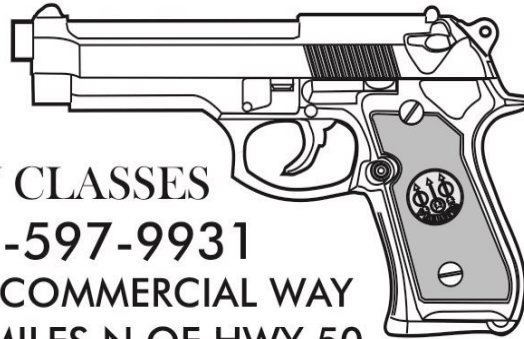

We hosted 14 candidates representing a variety of offices on the ballot for the August Primary. All political parties were represented. A complete video of the event has been posted to Hernando Beach Next Door. A series of BOCC workshops are being conducted to address the 1 cent sales tax and impact fees. Hernando County continues to grow and infrastructure needs are wanting to be addressed for the Sheriffs Department, Public Works and Schools. Approximately \$600(+)M in projects. About half for the Sheriffs Department, a quarter for roads and utilities and a quarter for the County Administration. Needs vs Wants. If you have an opinion reach out to the BOCC and let your opinion be heard. Budget discussions will start in earnest at the end of next month in preparation for passing the 2025 annual budget in September. The budget year starts on 1 Oct 2024. No updates on the Calienta drainage project and the Petit Lane improvements. The BOCC voted to increase the Administrators salary to \$250,000 per year. About a 30% raise. Motion made by Mr Hawkins and seconded by Mr Campbell. Mr Champion was the only opposing vote. Mrs Hawkins is a candidate for School Board. Commissioners are paid approximately \$83,000 per year and School Board members are paid \$42,000 per year for a part time job. To date there have been five candidate forums held in Hernando County. I anticipate 5-6 more before the August 20th primary. The capstone event is Politics in the Park hosted by the Chamber of Commerce. Worth attending if you would like to

be an informed voter before entering the polling location. Remember, it's your tax money. More information about the candidates can be found at the Supervisor of Elections Web page, <https://www.hernandovotes.gov>. Next months guest speaker will host a discussion about the inner workings of the Hernando County Planning and Zoning Commission. Consider attending to ask your questions.

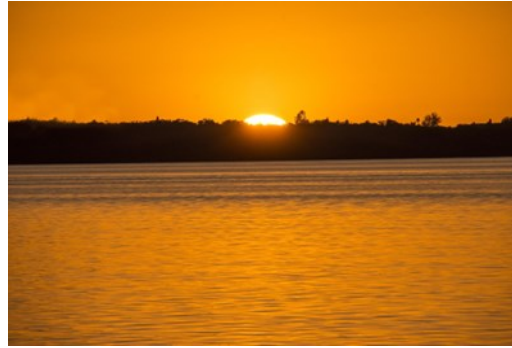

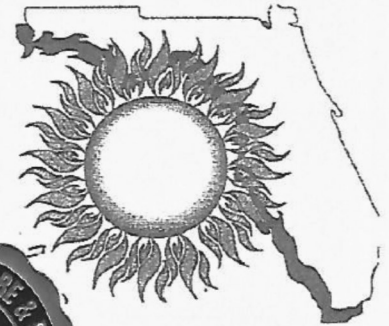

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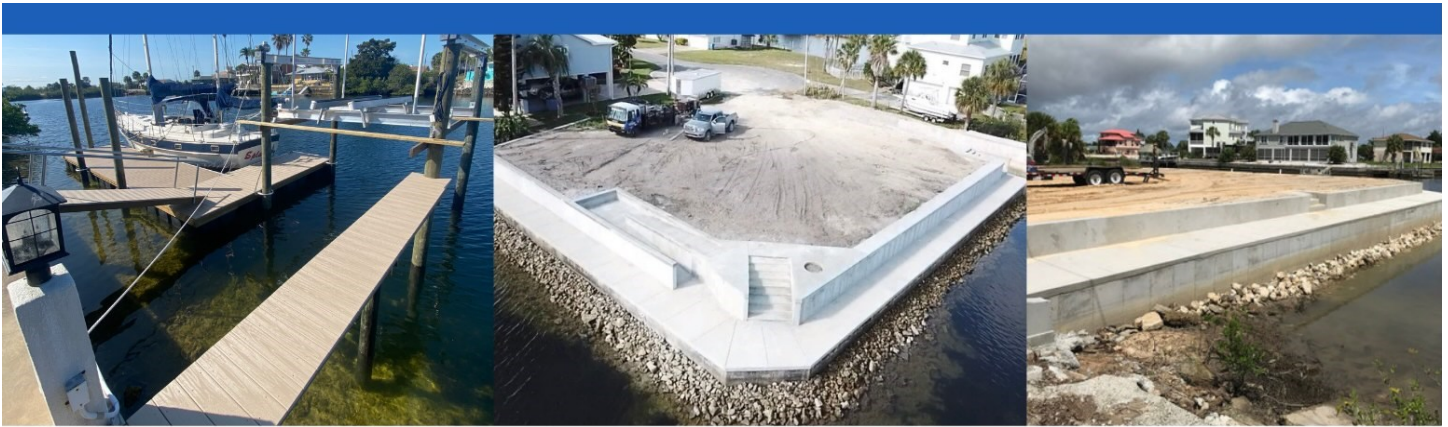

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violations were observed. The appropriate citations and warnings were issued.

MAY - Officer Kaitlin Taylor and Officer Specialist Reece Alvis were conducting individual fishing quota commercial reef fish inspections and found one vessel landed prior to its 3-hour landing notification. A vessel inspection found the captain to be in possession of 9 pounds of red snapper fillets. Reef fish are required to be landed in whole condition. The commercial vessel was also found to not possess the required turtle mitigation gear. Additional vessel registration and saltwater products license sticker

APRIL - Officers Hunter Caldwell and Clayton Heitt conducted a resource inspection on a vessel west of Hernando Beach. The captain was operating a hired fishing charter and acknowledged he was in federal waters. During the inspection, the vessel was found to be in possession of one red drum and one gray snapper. The captain will be cited federally for fishing without a permit, harvest of red drum in federal waters, and no charter vessel/head boat permit for reef fish.
