## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

A phrase my father used was "carpe diem"., I often wondered where it came from? Wikipedia attributes Quintus Horatius Flaccus (65 BC - 8 BC), commonly known in the English-speaking world as Horace. "The phrase is part of the longer carpe diem, quam minimum credula postero, which is often translated as "Seize the day, put very little trust in tomorrow (the future)". The ode says that the future is unforeseen and that one should not leave to chance future happenings, but rather one should do all one can today to make one's own future better."

When I was behind on a school project or fretting over a test my father would say "carpe diem William Edd." He left it to me to figure out what he meant. He was urging me to seize this moment in time because you don't know what tomorrow will bring much less the next few hours. I began to appreciate his guidance even more as I grew older and my own challenges increased in scope with pilot training tests, survival training, and nuclear weapon training for aviators. I can appreciate that my father's guidance and drive came from his own survival experience as a WWII B-17 POW who at the age of 21 was in Stalag Luft IV. Patty accuses me of having too much on my plate sometimes — she's right, I'm carpe diem at heart but moving more to the Jimmy Buffett (RIP) island style of beach living.

In the month of May, we had a candidate forum and listened to the folks who think that running for office is their calling. The tough part about that is we don't know too much about what they've done. We have to trust that they can follow through on their promises of what they intended to do once elected into office. Throughout the summer there will be more opportunities to listen to our candidates – seize the moment and go listen to those you may want to vote for.

This agenda item presents the legal documentation to execute the funds necessary to resurface Shoal Line Blvd from Caliente to Jewfish Drive – it does not include the Caliente Storm Water Drainage project. 

Government Affairs Committee Update for May 2024. Between now and November will be an exciting time for Hernando County Voters. The August Primary is the time we elect our Board of County Commissioners (BOCC), narrow down the list of School Board Members, elect our Circuit Court Judge, Sheriff, Property Appraiser and Tax Collector. The Clerk of Courts is currently unopposed. According to sources in the County Administration progress is being made to rebuild the network infrastructure that was subject to a ransom ware attack. Florida law does not allow government agencies to pay ransom for such attacks. A big shout out to the membership and board for a very successful candidates forum.





# FWC REPORTS HERNANDO COUNTY

MAY - Officer Kaitlin Taylor and Officer Specialist Reece Alvis were conducting individual fishing quota commercial reef fish inspections and found one vessel landed prior to its 3-hour landing notification. A vessel inspection found the captain to be in possession of 9 pounds of red snapper fillets. Reef fish are required to be landed in whole condition. The commercial vessel was also found to not possess the required turtle mitigation gear. Additional vessel registration and saltwater products license sticker

violations were observed. The appropriate citations and warnings were issued.

**APRIL** - Officers Hunter Caldwell and Clayton Heitt conducted a resource inspection on a vessel west of Hernando Beach. The captain was operating a hired fishing charter and acknowledged he was in federal waters. During the inspection, the vessel was found to be in possession of one red drum and one gray snapper. The captain will be cited federally for fishing without a permit, harvest of red drum in federal waters, and no charter vessel/head boat permit for reef fish.
