## **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

Greetings to all of our members, friends, and neighbors! I can hardly believe that it is mid-year already. It has always been true that "time flies" but in my experience with each passing year it seems to accelerate. You'll notice that this Beachcomber is a combined June/July issue. We will be going on summer hiatus following the June 4<sup>th</sup> membership meeting. No meetings are planned for July and August. We will keep in touch with issue of the Beachcomber for August and September and mark your calendars now for our September meeting on Thursday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> when we will celebrate getting back together with an ice cream social.

Our May meeting speakers were also well known fellow members. They were very informative and held everyone's attention and interest as evidenced by the interaction and questions. Sarah Hill, JT Realty & Associates, updated us on both the Hernando Beach and overall Hernando County real estate markets. Sarah discussed influences on the market, what differentiators buyers are looking for and recent market activity. Then Mike Fulford, our immediate past-President and a member of the Hernando County Planning & Zoning Commission, explained the function and quasi-judicial role of the commission and the realities and constraints they must operate under. Serendipitously, Brian Hawkins, district 2 Hernando County Commissioner, was in attendance and he fielded some questions and added information and insights from his perspective. Both

Mike and Brian pointed out that most development occurring today has been “on the books” and “in the works” for a long time. Also, many decisions are made at the state level and what can be controlled or restricted locally is very limited. Many thanks to Sarah and Mike, and to Brian for also jumping in. It was a very informative evening!

I shared with the membership at the meeting that the Board of Directors has been discussing the possibility of expanding our geographic boundaries and we would like to get members' input. There are several drivers to this discussion. A major one is that our membership has been significantly declining over the past year (down approx. 34%). There are likely many factors influencing that but clearly the post-Helene/Milton period has seen migration away from coastal areas and along with that more properties are being converted to short-term rentals (Airbnb, VRBO, etc.). There was a small expansion done to the HBPOA map in the last couple years to include several properties on Osowaw south of Shoal Line. The rationale for that included that they are adjacent, in the same zip code, have gulf access, and are in the same flood plane so presumably would have common interests and concerns with Hernando Beach as previously defined. What is being seriously considered now is to expand further south along Osowaw right up to the bridge at the Stone Crab Shack (Hernando County line). At the same time we are evaluating the pros and cons of possibly expanding northward on Shoal Line. This possibility has several possible variations. The most extreme would be to include not only Weeki Wachee Gardens but possibly Bayport and Pine Island as well. Again, nothing has been decided and we welcome everyone's input. Would including the possibility of members from these adjacent communities enhance our mission or dilute or compromise it? Is there enough commonality of interests to actually attract new members from outside of Hernando Beach “proper”? There were many thoughtful comments and suggestions made during the discussion, including that regardless of whether or not we expand our geographic field of membership we should explore increasing awareness and interaction with the existing neighborhood organizations in Weeki Wachee and Aripeka. We will pursue that outreach regardless of what expansion actions do or do not materialize. This discussion will continue at the June 4<sup>th</sup> meeting and beyond, hopefully leading to a decision in the Fall. We hope you will attend and let us know your opinions. In the meantime please feel free to contact me or any board member if you'd like more information or to share your thoughts.

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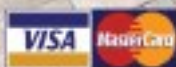
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## **CALIENTA PROJECT UPDATE**

"I would like to apologize for the delays associated with the Calienta project. During construction, conflicts were identified between the proposed drainage system and the existing sewer laterals which required revisions to the drainage design and subsequent adjustments in the field.

We are aware of the ongoing pothole concerns and are coordinating with the contractor to address them more frequently until they are fully mobilized on the project."

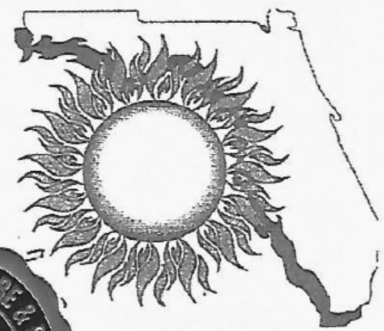
Hello June!

EFFECT JUNE 1, 2026**

May 13, 2026**

(Brooksville, FL) – Updated fees for Hernando County's **East Hernando and West Hernando Convenience Centers** will take effect **June 1, 2026**, following approval by the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) on December 16, 2025.

The East Hernando and West Hernando Convenience Centers are available for residential use only by property owners and residents who pay the annual solid waste disposal assessment through their property taxes. Residents must personally transport waste to the facility and provide proof of ownership or residency of a qualifying property. Commercial waste is not accepted at these locations.

**Convenience Center Fees**

- \$5.00 for up to five bags of household trash (maximum 60 gallons per bag.)
- \$15.00 per visit for loads containing more than five bags and for bulk loads.
- \$15.00 per visit for yard waste items, such as branches, under 8 inches in diameter and less than 10 inches in length.
- Recycling and residential household hazardous waste will continue to be accepted free of charge, but must be clearly identifiable. Materials should be brought in original containers, open bins, or clear bags for inspection. Plastic bags must be disposed of separately.

The Northwest Solid Waste Facility (Main Landfill) will no longer offer the free 2,000-pound allowance, and all waste brought in will now be charged by weight.

### **Convenience Center Usage Guidelines**

- Quantities over 100 cubic feet and all commercial waste must be taken to the Main Landfill.
- Residents are limited to one trip per day, regardless of the number of properties owned.
- Trailer use is limited to five visits per calendar year.
- Trailers must be less than 5 feet wide and 10 feet long.
- Loads are restricted to 2 feet high, except for furniture items such as couches, cabinets, and tables.
- Oversized vehicles, including dump trucks, moving vans, and similar vehicles, are prohibited.
- Residents must bring sufficient help for un-

loading, as team members do not assist with unloading items.

To reduce unload times and traffic congestion, small loads of loose debris equivalent to four recycling bins must be containerized or bundled. Larger loads, loose debris, and items exceeding 10 cubic feet, must be taken directly to the Main Landfill.

### **Accepted Materials**

- Convenience centers accept household trash, indoor furniture, electronics, clothing, bedding, and limited yard waste including grass clippings, leaves, and small branches.

### **Recycling**

- Recycling, including paper, cardboard, aluminum and steel cans, and rigid plastic containers, is accepted free of charge at all locations. Recyclables must be clean and free of trash, food waste, and plastic bags.

### **Household Hazardous Waste**

- Small quantities of residential household haz-

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ardous waste are accepted, including latex paint, used oil, fluorescent lamps, and lead acid and rechargeable batteries. Commercial hazardous waste is prohibited.

- **Sharps and Unwanted Medications**
- Syringes, lancets, and unwanted non-narcotic medications are accepted at all locations. They must be dropped off in approved sharps containers or containers made of heavy plastic, such as laundry detergent containers.

## Materials Not Accepted

- The Convenience Centers do not accept commercial waste, construction debris, land clearing debris, tires, automotive parts, chemicals, liquid waste, biomedical waste, radioactive materials, or other hazardous materials. These items must be taken to the Main Landfill or another approved disposal site.

The hours of operation for the West Hernando Convenience Center, East Hernando Convenience Center, and Main Landfill will remain un-

changed.

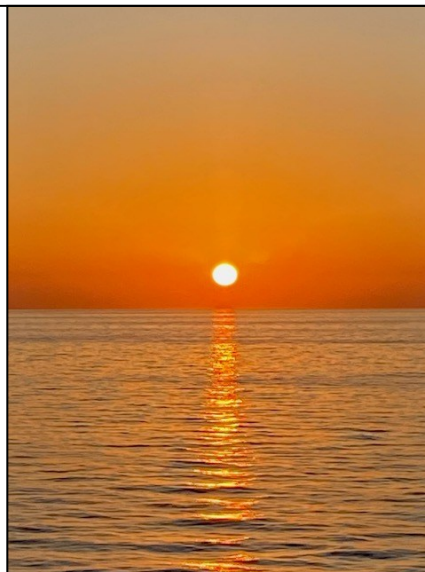
