Do I need prior lacrosse experience?

 No! We are a no-cut sport offering varsity and JV teams and plenty of ways for new players to contribute.
Beginners are fully encouraged. We have many first-time players in the program in addition to life-long laxers.

When is the season?

- The main season is spring from March to May. We also offer optional activities throughout the year, such as summer league, fall tournament, and winter league.
- What is the level of competition?
 - Pondo Lax is 4A in 2023 & staying 4A for 2024-2026.
 - CHSAA realigned the leagues again in 2023. We still compete in the Southern League, which is now Thomas Jefferson, Littleton, Lutheran, Air Academy (new), & Cheyenne Mountain (new). Pueblo West, Palmer, & Vanguard moved to 4A Metro.





- What are the preseason opportunities?
 - We're currently playing the Winter League at the Foothills Sports Arena. There are Wednesday morning offense chalk talks with Coach Dorr & Coach O'Brien and twice per week wall ball sessions in the Small Gym. Check the BAND calendar.

When and where are practices?

• There is a change for varsity in 2023. Lax cannot practice on the PHS Turf at the same time as either soccer or T&F. Coaches & AD are working on the detailed plan, but it's likely varsity will start at 4 pm on the lower grass & move to turf for 5-6 pm. We're also blocking time at EchoPark. JV is unchanged for upper grass 3:30-5:30 pm.

<u>Notes</u>

[1] All costs are estimates. The program keeps costs as low as possible. Volunteers are always welcome to help with fundraising to keep costs low.

[2] The estimated cost for the spring season is the sum of the district fee & booster fee.

[3] All equipment is purchased by and owned by the player. The program does not provide equipment. Short term loaners are available for players new to the sport.

[4] The program requires a black helmet. Orders are placed each fall at a significant discount to retail and the program usually has spares available for purchase. [5] Helmet decals are provided as part of the spring fees.

[6] Game uniforms are loaned to players at no cost and owned by the program.

[7] Practice uniforms are purchased every three years and owned by the player.

[8] There are mandatory practices and games over spring break in March. Do <u>not</u> plan a vacation for spring break.





What is the required uniform?

- The program provides game uniforms. Game shorts and game jersey are owned by the program and returned at the end of the season. The shooter shirt and socks are owned by the player and included in their fee.
- For practice, the program requires a certain reversible jersey. Players purchase the jersey for approx. \$35 and keep it. We change designs every 3 years to minimize the number of practice jerseys purchased in a 4-year high school career. In 2023, players can wear either the prior version or the new style. Players are asked to wear dark colored and mostly solid shorts or sweatpants.
- Players will need cold weather layers.





- How do I receive all communication?
 - Players & parents join BAND.
 - Players & parents should double check the accuracy of emails & phone numbers in our Google Sheet.
 - Players should confirm access to the playbook in Google Drive.
- How can I help the program?
 - Our booster club is called Crease Crew. We're always looking for volunteers. We need help in 2023 with fundraising, coordinating buses, & organizing team dinners.
- How can I promote the program?
 - Part of honoring the Medicine Game off the field is being a kind and likable ambassador.
 - Please follow us on Instagram and Facebook and like and share posts.





- How much does it cost?
 - The spring season is approximately \$650. Offseason activities are optional and vary in cost. All equipment is provided by each player. The program can loan some gear while a new player is deciding to make the full commitment.
 - The District fee is \$200; \$100 comes to the program.
 - The Crease Crew fee is expected in the range of \$375 to \$425. The final evaluation is underway.
 - Fees cover 3 of the 6 coaches, meals for certain away games, uniforms, helmet decals, transportation, game film services, supplies (goals, nets, balls, etc.), team photo & posters, & reserve for future uniforms.
 - Payment plans are welcome.
 - Completely transparent budget & tracking are available.


