



**Tribe After Tribe** is an outreach ministry that is dedicated to reaching the tribal people of NE-India and its neighbouring countries with the everlasting gospel— sharing it in their own languages.

On November 26, 1903, the Review and Herald published an article titled "A View of the Conflict", in which Ellen G. White described a powerful vision of the final events of earth's history. In Testimonies for the Church, Volume 8, page 41, she writes: "In vision I saw two armies in terrible conflict. One army was led by banners bearing the world's insignia; the other was led by the bloodstained banner of Prince IMMANUEL. Standard after standard was left to trail in the dust as company after company from the LORD's army joined the foe, and **tribe after tribe** from the ranks of the enemy united with the commandment-keeping people of GOD."

In the **10-40 window**, the most dedicated and fertile people to receive the Gospel are the tribal people. In fact, there are more than 260 million tribal people across Asia, representing more than 2,000 languages.

Could it be that what Ellen White is seeing in the last great conflict, is large numbers of people joining God's people from the remote areas of the earth? We believe so!

Ellen White emphasises that during the time of the Latter Rain, GOD's people will move forward like a mighty army under the banner of CHRIST—filled with the HOLY SPIRIT, united, and proclaiming the Loud Cry, calling all to make their final decision for eternity.

It is with this prophetic vision in mind that we are inspired to labor earnestly with JESUS—bringing the gospel **tribe after tribe**, praying that this work will help to hasten HIS soon return.

GOD is working in wonderful ways to reach the tribes, and we're excited to share with you in brief what HE is doing through **Tribe After Tribe Ministry**.





In just a few short months, we've witnessed the mighty hand of GOD at work through **Tribe After Tribe Ministry**. Day by day, we continue to see GOD lead, provide, and open doors— beyond what we ever asked or imagined. Our initial focus was on translating and printing gospel books in tribal languages—making the Word of GOD accessible in the tribal language of the people. And now, by HIS grace, the ministry is expanding!

Here's what GOD is doing through Tribe After Tribe:

#### • Words of Life - Adventist Bookstore in Dimapur

This bookstore is the only Adventist store in the entire town and it serves as a center of influence sharing the truth through books and literature, while also offering medical missionary work to meet physical needs and lead souls to CHRIST.

#### Outreach Through a School in Sikkim :

Sikkim is one of the most challenging regions for sharing the Truth. Yet, we praise God for the privilege of adopting an elementary school where we can teach children about JESUS and equip them with English skills—helping them to read the Bible for themselves and grow in their faith.

#### Evangelistic Meetings and Youth Bible Camps

We have hosted Bible camps and training programs across Northeast India to revive a passion for CHRIST in young hearts and raise up workers for the LORD. We also conducted two large evangelistic meetings in **Nagaland** and **Mizoram**. The Lord greatly blessed these efforts—about **380** precious souls have been baptised after the meetings. And we are praying for opportunities to hold many more!

#### Partnership with Amazing Facts India

We are blessed to work closely with Amazing Facts India, translating and printing books and Bible study guides in tribal languages. This partnership is multiplying our reach and impact with sound biblical resources.

• IMPACT India (Institute for Ministry Preparation, Action, Change, and Triumph) We praise GOD for the launch of this Bible school to train young people for mission service. The harvest is truly great, and we believe IMPACT India will help us reach **tribe** after tribe more effectively—and hasten the coming of JESUS.

Today, we are blessed to have over **10** active **Tribe After Tribe** missionaries serving in various regions. We could not have come this far without the powerful leading of GOD—and your faithful support through prayer.





# Reaching Tribals through literature

In partnership with Amazing Facts India, we've printed Bible study guides in four tribal languages: **Sumi, Garo, Bodo, and Kuki**—now ready for distribution! Additionally, we also have Steps to Christ translated into **Hmar, Meitei, Tangkhul, and Lotha** and is currently awaiting print.

Our priority goal is to have **Steps to Christ** and **the Great controversy** books translated and made available for tribals in their own language.

### Weekly Marketplace Outreach

Every Wednesday, we set up a booth at the local marketplace to connect with people—offering Adeventist books, health checks (glucose and blood pressure), prayer, and guidance on healthy living through wholesome foods and practical lifestyle tips.

Recently, someone picked up a book and said, "This is the book you were looking for. It answers your questions about meat eating."

It gives us so much joy in sharing not just knowledge, but the Truth.

We're also seeing a growing curiosity about the Sabbath truth—even during conversations on public transport. We praise GOD!

We're also seeing growing interest from more tribal translators—praise GOD for this opportunity to reach more tribes for JESUS!

Our team has been actively distributing printed gospel books in various tribal languages, traveling to remote mountain villages to reach those who have never heard the message. We're especially thankful for the young people from different tribes across Northeast India who are joining the effort—sharing the printed books with their tribes and communities. We believe that their involvement is taking the gospel to reach tribe after tribe.

# Colporteur Training

From February 3 to 6, 2025, we had a colporteur training program in Dimapur in partnership with **AF India** and **Tribe After Tribe Ministry**. Around 15 individuals joined the training.

The sessions were led by **Dr. Charles**, **Pr. Thangliana Fanai**, and **Pr. Dhormo Kamei**.

We're excited to share that we now have about **9 colporteurs in different states and villages of NE-India.** We praise GOD for helping us take the gospel through literature to different corners of NE-India.







#### Medical Mission and the Word of GOD

Recently, we had the privilege of visiting a village of the Kuki tribe. The village has only one church, and it was there that we were warmly welcomed, right after their Sunday service, to conduct a health outreach camp.

Medical missionary work has proven to be the entering wedge into many tribal communities, and this visit was no exception. It was a blessing to serve the villagers through basic health checks and consultations. Many were found to be suffering from hypertension and diabetes—conditions that are often undiagnosed and untreated. Their response was very positive, and they earnestly requested us to return. Our prayer is not only that we will return, but that the entire church will one day be fully converted and walk in the Truth of the Word of God.

Another recent encounter for which we truly thank God was with a church pastor and his wife, who pastor a congregation made up of eight different tribes. They asked us for a ride to Dimapur, which turned into a beautiful divine appointment. We invited them to our home for breakfast, shared some of our books with them, and they were overjoyed.

The pastor later invited us to preach at his church on a Sunday.

What a blessing it was to attend their service and share the importance of living according to the Word of God and walking in obedience.

We are seeing GOD opening doors of opportunities for Tribal outreach and we believe that we must be swift messengers as sister White counsels us. We praise HIM for how HE is leading us forward.





#### Institute for Ministry Preparation, Action, Change and Triumph

IMPACT India is a 3 and  $\frac{1}{2}$  month missionary training program in NE-India.

We are excited for what God will accomplish through IMPACT India. We truly believe this training program is divinely inspired—designed to equip and empower young people for impactful, frontline mission work.

Our vision is to raise up young people to be Spirit-filled missionaries, passionate for the Lord, who will help us reach **tribe after tribe** with the gospel and hasten the return of Jesus.

We also raised some funds to support an Adventist school near the border by providing refugee children with school textbooks and basic needs, helping them in their education and growing in their knowledge of JESUS.

In a small village of the **Rongmei** tribe in the hills of Manipur lives a Seventh-day Adventist family—the only one in the entire village. For over 20 years, they have struggled to remain true to their faith, holding on to the Sabbath truth.

The villagers often encourage them to leave the Adventist Church and join the larger Catholic group. In fact, they have even been invited to officially join the Catholic Church in the coming year. But this family refuses. Their hearts are firm in the truth they have received, and they have no desire to leave the Seventh-day Adventist Church.

Last year, an evangelist and a pastor from the conference visited and held a small cottage meeting. That brief visit brought great encouragement to the family and reminded them that they are not alone. The greatest desire of this family is this: "A church must rise."

A small Adventist church in this village could be the beginning of something greater—it could be the door through which the gospel enters the village.

# The Work Before Us: Equipping, Sending, and Reaching

As we look ahead, we carry a deep burden for the following mission needs:

- **Bibles & Education**: We desire to provide good quality Bibles and educational support for needy tribal children, so they can grow in the knowledge of Jesus and become missionaries to their own people.
- **Church Building**: We long to help build small churches in remote villages, giving believers a place to worship and fellowship together every Sabbath.
- **Missionaries**: "The harvest is great, but the laborers are few." With the work rapidly increasing, our small team often grows weary and physically exhausted. We see the urgent need for more missionaries to join us so the work can move forward without delay—hastening the return of our LORD.
- Tribe After Tribe Mission Campus: The Lord has provided land for us on the
  outskirts of Dimapur city. We are now praying for the resources to build a
  mission campus—complete with a meeting hall that can accommodate
  500 people or more, simple apartments to house missionaries, host training
  programs and evangelistic meetings.
