Vito Sasseville caught a 21.5 inch Speckled Trout in Dutchman's with Captain Dave Mullaney



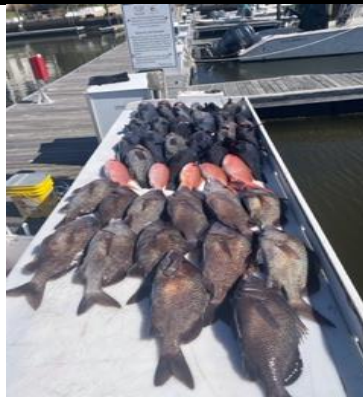
John Hussey caught a 21 inch Speckled Trout in Dutchman's on his kayak
