PICK SOMETHING YOU WOULD DRESS YOUR CHILD IN FOR CHURCH OR A WEDDING. **ATTIRE WILL NOT BE SCORED!!!** NATURAL HAIR AND MAKEUP **ONLY!** FOR AGES 6-23 YEARS, FORMAL PAGEANT ATTIRE SUCH AS GLITZ, CUPCAKE, BALL GOWN, ETC. **ATTIRE** WILL NOT BE SCORED! NO SPORTS BRAS! PLEASE KEEP ATTIRE APPROPRIATE. FULL HAIR AND MAKEUP ARE ALLOWED, BUT NOT MANDATORY.

3. SCORING

CONTESTANTS WILL BE SCORED ON THE FOLLOWING: FACIAL BEAUTY, PERSONALITY, AND OVERALL APPEARANCE SCORE SHEETS WILL NOT BE GIVEN OUT!

4. REHEARSAL

CONTESTANTS WILL BE **REQUIRED** TO ATTEND (MANDATORY) REHEARSAL ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 30th, IN THE BC LLOYD BUILDING. EACH CONTESTANT WILL RECEIVE THEIR NUMBER, AND PRACTICE THE PATTERN ON STAGE. AGES 0-5 YEARS AT 5:00 PM AGES 6-13 YEARS AT 6:00 PM AGES 14-23 AT 7:00 PM PLEASE BRING SHOES THAT THE CONTESTANT WILL WALK IN SO THEY CAN PRACTICE IN THOSE SHOES! WELCOME TO THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT!

THE CONTESTANT RESUME IS YOUR OPPORTUNITY TO DEMONSTRATE TO THE JUDGES WHY THEY SHOULD CONSIDER YOU FOR THE JOB OF MISS GREENE COUNTY/JR MISS GREENE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN. YOU MAY LIST AS MANY OR AS FEW ITEMS UNDER EACH CATEGORY AS YOU DESIRE, THE ONLY RESTRICTION IS THAT YOU MUST FOLLOW THE ESTABLISHED FORMAT AND IT MUST BE TYPED (FITTING ON ONE PAGE.) ALL INFORMATION THAT DOES NOT FIT ON ONE RESUME PAGE WILL BE DISCARDED!

THE JUDGES WILL BE GIVEN EXACTLY WHAT IS SUBMITTED ON THE ONE PAGE.

AFTER THE RESUME IS RECEIVED BY THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT DIRECTOR/BOARD, NO ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED. ALL CONTESTANTS ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO HAVE THEIR RESUME PROOFREAD PRIOR TO SUBMISSION. CONTESTANTS SHOULD ADHERE TO CORRECTLY UTILIZING GRAMMAR AND MECHANICS IN ADDITION TO SPELLING.

- 1. MARGINS SHOULD BE SET FOR 1" ON ALL FOUR SIDES. THE FONT STYLE MAY BE NO SMALLER THAN "10" AND NO LONGER THAN "12" POINT TYPE, USING ONLY THE *TIMES NEW ROMAN* FONT STYLE.
- 2. YOU ARE NOW READY TO BEGIN! THE CONTESTANT'S NAME WILL BE THE FIRST FIELD COMPLETED. THE CONTESTANT'S NAME SHOULD BE TYPED AS YOU WISH FOR THE JUDGES TO KNOW IN ADDITION TO HOW THE CONTESTANT DESIRES THEIR NAME TO BE ANNOUNCED PUBLICLY/UTILIZED FOR PUBLICITY. EXAMPLE: IF THE NAME IS ELIZABETH JANE DOE AND THE CONTESTANT ONLY WISHES TO BE CALLED JANE DOE, PLEASE STATE THE NAME AS SUCH.
- 3. STATE THE TITLE YOU ARE COMPETING FOR. EXAMPLE: JR. MISS GREENE COUNTY OR MISS GREENE COUNTY. BE SURE TO SPECIFY!
- 4. STATE CONTESTANT'S HOME (MAILING) ADDRESS. PLEASE LIST THE ENTIRE ADDRESS INCLUDING ZIP CODE.
- 5. STATE CNTESTANT'S AGE (MONTH/DAY/YEAR) TAB TWICE AND PROVIDE YOUR AGE.
- 6. EDUCATION: BEGIN WITH YOUR CURRENT SCHOOL, STATING ADDITIONAL SCHOOLS THEREAFTER. BE SURE TO PRESS ENTER TO SPACE YOUR SCHOOLS OUT!
- 7. SCHOLASTIC HONORS: EACH HONOR SHOULD BE SEPERATED BY A SEMICOLON (;) PLEASE KEEP IN MIND ONLY ONE PAGE MAY BE SUBMITTED. LIST YOUR MOST CURRENT FIRST.
- 8. GREATEST ACHIEVEMENTS AND LEADERSHIP ACHIEVEMENTS: ALL INFORMATION SHOULD BE SEPERATED BY A SEMICOLON (;) LIST MOST CURRENT FIRST.
- 9. AMBITION FOR THE FUTURE: THE CONTESTANT'S CURRENT AMBITION AT THIS POINT IN THEIR LIFE SHOULD BE EVIDENTLY DEFINED. REMEMBER, WISHFUL THINKING NEVER HURT ANYONE!

GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT RULES

- CONTESTANTS FOR THE TITLE OF MISS MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE AND NOT MORE THAN 23 YEARS OF AGE ON THE DAY OF
 THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT. ANY CONTESTANT PARTICIPATING IN THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR QUEEN
 COMPETITION MAY ONLY HOLD THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTY/DISTRICT TITLE. CONTESTANTS HOLDING ADDITIONAL TITLES
 OF ANY KIND WILL BE INELIGIBLE TO COMPETE.
- 2. HOWEVER, IF YOU ARE A SENIOR IN HIGH SCHOOL AND YOU WILL BE ATTENDING COLLEGE IN THE FALL YOU MAY COMPETE IN THE MISS COMPETITION. THIS IS THE ONLY EXCEPTION!
- 3. A CONTESTANT MUST HAVE BEEN BORN A FEMALE AND A LEGAL RESIDENT OF GREENE COUNTY. SHE CANNOT BE, AND AT ANY TIME HAVE BEEN MARRIED, ENGAGED, PREGNANT, OR HAVE A CHILD. ALSO, IF CROWNED QUEEN, SHE MAY NOT GET MARRIED UNTIL SHE HAS FULFILLED HER TITLE'S TERM. A CONTESTANT MUST NOT HAVE EVER BEEN CONVICTED OF ANY CRIME OR HAVE CRIMINAL CHARGES OF ANY KIND PENDING.
- 4. PAST GREENE COUNTY JR/MISS QUEENS ARE INELIGIBLE TO COMPETE AGAIN FOR THE SAME GIVEN TITLE.
- 5. ONLY GREENE COUNTY RESIDENTS ARE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT. ATTENDING A SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY DOES NOT CONSTITUTE RESIDENCY. IN THE EVENT A CONTESTANT (WHOSE PARENTS ARE DIVORCED AND LIVE IN SEPARATE COUNTIES) HAS BEEN COURT ORDERED TO RESIDE JOINTLY WITH BOTH PARENTS, MAY COMPETE IN TWO COUNTIES IN WHICH SHE RESIDES. IE: IF THE FAMILIES RESIDE IN TWO DIFFERENT COUNTIES, THE CONTESTANT CAN COMPETE IN ONLY ONE COUNTYCONTEST. THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO VERIFY ACCURATE RESIDENCY, ACCORDING TO THE ABOVE SAID COURT DOCUMENTS OR ANY ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION.
- 6. THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR REQUIRES THE JR AND MISS WINNERS TO ATTEND THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR COMPETITION.
 ALL OTHER COUNTY CONTESTANTS THAT COMPETED IN THEIR RESPECTIVE COUNTIES MAY THEN PROCEED TO COMPETE IN
 THEIR DISTRICT COMPETITIONS AS WELL AS THE CAPITOL CITY COMPETITION. THROUGH THESE AVENUES, A CONTESTANT
 HAS THREE OPPORTUNITIES TO ATTEND THE ARKANSAS STATE FAIR COMPETITION. CAPITOL CITY IS AN OPEN
 PRELIMINARYCOMPETITION FOR ALL CONTESTANTS THAT HAVE PARTICIPATED IN THEIR COUNTY AND DISTRICT
 COMPETITIONS OF THAT CALENDAR YEAR. IN ADDITION, ANY PREVIOUS COUNTY OR DISTRICT FAIR QUEENS MAY
 PARTICIPATE IN CAPITOL CITY AS LONG AS THEY MEET THE AGE REQUIREMENTS.
- 7. CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO BE ON TIME FOR REHEARSAL, INTERVIEW, AND PRODUCTION TIME. ABSENT OR TARDY CONTESTANTS MAY BE DISQUALIFIED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE CONTEST DIRECTOR. IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO ATTEND OR BE ON TIME DUE TO AN EMERGENCY, CONTACT THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT DIRECTOR.
- 8. CONTESTANT RESUMES (JR/MISS) ARE REQUIRED TO BE ON TIME FOR REHEARSAL, INTERVIEW, AND PRODUCTION TIME. ALL RESUMES SHOULD BE SIGNED BY THE CONTESTANT AND THEIR PARENT/GUARDIAN. ALL RESUMES MUST BE TURNED IN BY 4:00 PM ON REHEARSAL DAY. NO ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER A RESUME IS SUBMITTED. EACH JUDGE WILL RECEIVE A COPY OF THE CONTESTANT'S RESUME. CONTESTANTS SHOULD ADHERE TO THE RESUME INSTRUCTIONS PROVIDED. CONTESTANTS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO HAVE THEIR RESUMES PROOFREAD PRIOR TO SUBMISSION.
- 9. ALL JR/MISS CONTESTANTS ARE REQUIRED TO UTILIZE THE ASSIGNED DRESSING AREA AT THE BC LLOYD BUILDING. ONLY ONE PERSON IS ALLOWED BACKSTAGE WITH A CONTESTANT DUE TO LIMITED SPACE. HAIR AND MAKEUP IS ALLOWED, BUT STRONGLY SUGGESTED TO BE TO BE DONE BEFORE ARRIVING.
- 10. CONTESTANTS IN THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN PAGEANT MUST CONDUCT THEMSELVES PROPERLY AT ALL TIMES. INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR BRINGING UNFAVORABLE PUBLICITY TO HERSELF AND/OR THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR WILL RESULT IN RELINQUISHMENT OF TITLE AND THE FOREFEITURE AND RETURN OF ANY/ALL PRIZES AND MONETARY AWARDS. ANY DISPLAY OF POOR SPORTSMANSHIP AND/OR UNBECOMING CONDUCT, ANY INTERFERENCE AND/OR DISTURBANCE, OR ANY OTHER BEHAVIORAL PROBLEM CREATED BY CONTESTANT, TRAVELLING COMPANION, PARENTS, RELATIVE, OR EVEN A SUPPORTOR/SPONSOR OF A CONTESTANTCOULD RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION OF THE CONTESTANT NOT ONLY FROM THIS YEAR'S COMPETITION BUT ALL OTHER FUTURE CONTESTS.
- 11. THE CONTESTANTS OF THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR QUEEN PAGEANT MUST HAVE PHYSICAL AND MENTAL CAPABILITIES TO PARTICIPATE IN THIS CONTEST. THE WINNER MUST ALSO MAINTAIN SUCH SAID CAPABILITIES IN ORDER TO FULFILL ASSIGNED DUTIES AND STRENUOUS WORKING SCHEDULE
- 12. THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR CONTEST DIRECTOR AND MANAGEMENT OF THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR RESERVE THE ABSOLUTE RIGHT TO INTERPRET THESE RULES AND ARBITRARILY SETTLE AND DETERMINE ALL MATTERS, QUESTIONS, AND DIFFERENCES IN REGARD THERETO, OR OTHERWISE ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH, OR INCIDENT TO THE CONTEST, AND THE RIGHT TO AMMEND OR ADD TO THESE RULES AS THE JUDGEMENT MAY DETERMINE. ANY CONTESTANT WHO FAILS TO ABIDE BY ANY OF THE ABOVE RULES OR ANY RULE STATEMENT GIVEN ORALLY MAY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT BY THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR PAGEANT DIRECTOR AND/OR GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD MANAGEMENT.

GREENE COUNTY FAIR GENERAL RULES

- 1. THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BEGINS ON LABOR DAY AND RUNS THROUGH THE FOLLOWING SATURDAY
- 2. THE FAIR ASSOCIATION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS, DAMAGE, OR INJURY TO ANY EXHIBIT OR ANIMAL DURING THE FAIR
- 3. NO ROVING VENDORS OR SOLICITORS, ACTING FOR EITHER A PROFIT OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION OR ON HIS/HER OWN BEHALF SHALL BE PERMITTED ON THE GREENE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF VENDING FOOD AND SOFT DRINKS OR SELLING ANYTHING FOR THE BENEFIT OF PATRONS ATTENDING SCHEDULED EVENTS THEREIN. ALL SOLICITATIONS FOR CONTRIBUTIONS MUST BE MADE WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BOOTH OR DISPLAY UNLESS OTHERWISE EXEMPTED BY THIS REGULATION.
- 4. PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID ONLY ON ITEMS LISTED IN THIS CATALOG
- 5. ALL CHECKS MAY BE PICKED UP AT THE FAIR OFFICE SUNDAY AFTERNOON AT THE APPOINTED TIME. ALL CHECKS NOT CALLED FOR WILL BE MAILED THE WEEK FOLLOWING THE FAIR
- 6. COMPETITION IS ONLY OPEN TO BONAFIDE RESIDENTS OF GREENE COUNTY. ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITORS MUST LIVE IN GREENE COUNTY OR ATTEND A GREENE COUNTY SCHOOL. CLASSES ARE DIVIDED INTO JUNIOR/SENIOR/OPEN DIVISIONS AND NO ENTRY MAY BE SHOWN IN TWO DIVISIONS. (NO ANIMAL OR ENTRY CAN BE SHOWN IN BOTH JUNIOR AND SENIOR/OPEN DIVISIONS.) WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE PEN OF THREE STEER CLASS
- 7. PROTEST ALL PROTESTS MUST BE IN WRITING. SUCH PROTESTS MUST STATE PLAINLY THE CAUSE OF COMPLAINT AND MUST BE DELIVERED TO THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD EITHER PRIOR TO JUDGING OR WITHIN TWO HOURS AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE DIVISIONAL JUDGING. ANY PROTESTS AS TO THE ELIGIBILITY ON ACCOUNT OF AGE, BREEDING, OR OWNERSHIPOF ANIMALS MUST BE FILED WITH THE FAIR BOARD PRIOR TO THE DAY ON WHICH THEY ARE TO BE JUDGED. JUDGING PROCEDURES WILL NOT BE INTERRUPTED FOR PROTEST INVESTIGATIONS. DEPENDING ON THE BASIS OF THE PROTEST, A DECISION MAY BE WITHHELD UNTIL A THOROUGH INVESTIGATION IS COMPLETED BY THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD, WHOSE DECISION WILL BE FINAL. IN ADDITION, ON THE RIGHT TO PROTEST THEREIN GRANTED TO AN EXHIBITOR, THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO TAKE OBSERVANCE OF FRAUD MADE OR ATTEMPT IN CONNECTION WITH ANY EXHIBIT AND TAKE SUCH ACTION AS MAY BE DEEMED JUST AND PROPER, AND AS MAY BE WARRANTED IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES. NO PROTEST BASED UPON THE STATEMENT THAT THE JUDGE OR JUDGES ARE INCOMPETENT WILL BE CONSIDERED. ALL QUESTIONS IN DISPUTE OR DIFFERENCE NOT COVERED BY THESE RULES WILL BE REFERRED TO THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD WHOSE DECISION WILL BE FINAL. AN EXHIBITOR WHO VIOLATES ANY OF THE RULES WILL FORFEIT ALL PRIVILEGES AND PREMIUMS AND BE SUBJECTED TO SUCH PENALTY AS THE FAIR MANAGEMENT MAY ORDER
- 8. THERE SHALL BE ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ALLOWED TO BE SOLD, BARTERED, POSSESSED, OR CONSUMED ON THE GREENE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS AT ANY TIME DURING THE FAIR ACTIVITIES. ANYONE FOUND TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THIS RULE SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS AND PROHIBITED FROM RETURNING DURING THE REMAINING FAIR ACTIVITIES
- 9. ALL MATERIALS DEEMED OFFENSIVE OR OBSCENE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED
- 10. NO UNAUTHORIZED ANIMALS ALLOWED ON THE GROUNDS


LIVESTOCK GENERAL RULES

- 1. ALL PREMIUMS ON LIVESTOCK WILL BE PAID BY THE FAIR ASSOCIATION ON A POINTS SYSTEM. AN ASSIGNED NUMBER OF POINTS MAY BE EARNED IN EACH CLASS. AT THE CLOSE OF THE SHOW ALL POINTS IN THE LIVESTOCK DIVISION WILL BE TOTALED. TOTAL NUMBER OF POINTS WILL BE DIVIDED INTO THE MONEY AVAILABLE TO DETERMINE THE CASH VALUE OF EACH POINT. THE VALUE MULTIPLIED BY THE NUMBER OF POINTS WILL EQUAL THE AMOUNT OF PRIZE MONEY EARNED
- 2. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE OWNED AND IN POSSESSION OF THE EXHIBITOR BY JULY 1ST PRIOR TO SHOWING.
- 3. LIVESTOCK ENTERED WILL BE CARED FOR BY THE OWNERS
- 4. EACH EXHIBITOR IS LIMITED TO TWO ENTRIES PER CLASS
- 5. ALL CATTLE, SWINE, SHEEP, AND GOATS ENTERED IN BREEDING CLASSES MUST BE PUREBRED AND REGISTERED ANIMALS. REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST BE IN THE POSSESSION OF THE EXHIBITOR OR A LETTER FROM THE BREED ASSOCIATION STATING THE REGISTRY IS PENDING. DAIRY CATTLE, MARKET STEERS, COMMERCIAL HEIFERS, MARKET HOGS, MARKET LAMBS, COMMERCIAL GOATS, AND MARKET GOATS MAY BE GRADE ANIMALS
- 6. ALL LIVESTOCK MUST BE PRE-REGISTERED ONLINE THROUGH THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR WEBSITE BY THE APPROPRIATE ANNUAL DEADLINE SET BY THE FAIR BOARD
- 7. EXHIBITORS OF LIVESTOCK WILL BE ISSUED ONE PASS PER EXHIBITOR. ADDITIONAL PASSES MAY BE PURCHASED FOR \$20.00 EACH. VEHICLE PASSES WILL BE ISSUED FOR ENTRY INTO THE FAIRGROUNDS. NO VEHICLES PERMITTED THROUGH THE GATES BETWEEN 12:00 PM AND CLOSING EACH DAY. NO VEHICLE PERMITTED THROUGH THE LIVESTOCK GATE WITHOUT VEHICLE PASS DISPLAYED IN WINDOW
- 8. ALL LIVESTOCK MUST BE IN PLACE BY 10:00 AM MONDAY MORNING AND WILL BE RELEASED AT 10:00 PM SATURDAY. ANY OPEN EXHIBITOR(S) 55 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WILL BE RELEASED ON WEDNESDAY EVENING FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF THE CATTLE SHOW. ANY REMOVAL OF LIVESTOCK FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS PRIOR TO 10:00 PM SATURDAY (UNLESS APPROVED BY THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD) WILL RESULT IN THE LOSS OF PRIZE/PREMIUM MONEY EARNED
- 9. ALL LIVESTOCK PENS WILL BE ASSIGNED BY THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR BOARD.
- 10. ALL LIVESTOCK PENS MUST BE CLEANED OUT BY 10:00 AM EACH DAY. REFUSE MUST BE DISPOSED OF AS DIRECTED BY FAIR MANAGEMENT. TIE OUT TIMES FOR CATTLE WILL BE 9:00 PM MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY, AND 10:00 PM FRIDAY NIGHT
- 11. ALL PENS MUST BE CLEANED COMPLETELY AT THE TIME OF REMOVAL OF ANIMAL AND/OR BEFORE PREMIUM CHECKS WILL BE ISSUED. (CATTLE STALLS MUST HAVE ALL MANURE REMOVED)
- 12. ONLY WOOD SHAVINGS SHALL BE ALLOWED AS BEDDING IN THE LIVESTOCK BARN. ONLY STRAW MAY BE USED IN THE CATTLE TIE OUT AREA. BEDDING IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR. REFUSE SHALL BE DISPOSED OF AS DIRECTED BY THE FAIR BOARD
- 13. THERE WILL BE ONLY ONE OFFICIAL WEIGH IN FOR MARKET ANIMALS. NO RE-WEIGHS
- 14. SHOW ORDERS FOR EACH SPECIES WILL BE POSTED PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF EACH RESPECTIVE SHOW
- 15. ALL LIVESTOCK SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES WILL TAKE PLACE BEFORE THE MARKET CLASSES OF EACH SPECIES
- 16. SHOWMANSHIP AGES ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 PEE WEE 5-8 YEARS OF AGE, JUNIOR 9-13 YEARS OF AGE, SENIOR 14-19 YEARS OF AGE
- 17. THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO HAVE BLOOD AND/OR URINE LABORATORY ANALYSIS MADE FOR ILLEGAL DRUGS FOR ANY ANIMAL AT THEIR FAIR. ANY EXHIBITOR ADMINISTERING A DRUG TO AN ANIMAL WHICH WOULD RENDER THE CARCASS UNFIT FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION OR ANY EXHIBITOR OF ANY ANIMAL PRODUCING AN ANALYSIS INDICATING THE PRESENCE OF AN UNAPPROVED DRUG THAT CAN RESULT QUANTITATIVE CHANGE IN THE CHARACTERISTIC OF THE ANIMAL WILL BE REQUIRED TO RETURN ALL PREMIUM MONEY AND COULD BE BANNED FROM FURTHER COMPETITION. THEIR NAME AND THE LAB ANALYSIS WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE USDA AND FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION AND POSSIBLE PROSECUTION. DISCLOSURE: ANY ANIMAL RECEIVING MEDICATION FOR ANY LIFE-THREATENING DISEASE OR ILLNESS MUST BE REGISTERED AT THE TIME THEY ARE ENTERED IN THE FAIR
- 18. NO CHANGES TO ENTRIES WILL BE ALLOWED WITHIN AN HOUR OF THE BEGINNING OF THE RESPECTIVE SHOW
- 19. BREEDING CLASSES ARE OPEN TO ADULTS (OPEN) AND JUNIORS, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF COMMERCIAL HEIFER AND COUNTY BRED HEIFER CLASSES. MARKET CLASSES ARE ONLY OPEN TO JUNIOR EXHIBITORS
- 20. IN ANY BREEDING SHOW, A BREED MUST HAVE 3 ANIMALS AND 2 EXHIBITORS IN ORDER TO HAVE ITS OWN BREED SHOW. ALL OTHERS WILL SHOW IN "ALL OTHER BREED" (AOB)
- 21. ALL MARKET CLASSES WILL BE DIVIDED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE FAIR BOARD
- 22. ANY ANIMAL SHOWING SYMPTOMS OF ABCESSES OR OTHER INFECTIOUS DISEASES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW AND MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS IMMEDIATELY

COMMERCIAL BUILDING

TO RESERVE BOOTH SPACE, CONTACT THE FAIR OFFICE
COMMERCIAL BOOTHS MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY NOON, SATURDAY PRIOR TO THE FAIR

ANY MATERIALS DEEMED OFFENSIVE OR OBSCENE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED

DIMENSION LIMITATIONS – BOOTHS CANNOT BE HIGHER THAN 6 FEET BACKS AND 4 FEET SIDES. ALL BOOTHS ARE 8 FEET DEEP. NO BOOTH SHALL EXTEND INTO THE AISLE PAST THE 8 FOOT DEPTH BOOTH DIMENSION. NO RULES APPLY AS TO WHAT CAN BE GIVEN AWAY BY EXHIBITORS (EXCEPTION: NO PREPARED FOODS CAN BE GIVEN AWAY.) THE FAIR ASSOCIATION REQUIRES THAT PRIZE WINNERS BE NOTIFIED OF WINNINGS. WINNERS AND GIFTS ARE NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION OR THE FAIR OFFICE. PLEASE MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR HOLDING YOUR GIFTS AND MONEY BAGS IN A SAFE PLACE (THEY MAY NOT BE LEFT IN THE FAIR OFFICE FOR SAFEKEEPING.) ANYTHING LEFT IN THE FAIR OFFICE IS NOT THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GREENE COUNTY FAIR ASSOCIATION. THE DRAWING WINNERS MAY BE ANNOUNCED FROM THE FAIR OFFICE

EXHIBITION HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

FOR LIVESTOCK, POULTRY, AND EXOTIC ANIMALS

(ACT 87 OF 1963, ACT 150 OF 1985, AND ACT 1306 OF 1997) (ISSUED JANUARY 15, 2004. EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2004)

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. CERTIFICATES OF VETERINARY INSPECTION AND ENTRY PERMITS:

"CERTIFICATES OF VETERINARY INSPECTION" REFERS TO A LEGIBLE RECORD (MADE ON AN OFFICIAL FORM ISSUED FROM THE STATE OF ORIGIN) BY AN ACCREDITED VETERINARIAN, WHICH SHOWS THAT THE ANIMALS LISTED THEREON MEET HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE OF DESTINATION. IT MUST BEAR THE IDENTIFICATION OF EACH ANIMAL AND SEPARATE CERTIFICATES MUST BE MADE FOR EACH SPECIES OF ANIMAL ENTERED. ENTRY PERMITS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL OUT OF STATE SWINE, RODEO BULLS, UNLESS THEY ARE TESTED WITHIN 30 DAYS OF ENTRY, PSITTACINE, PASSERINES, RATITES, ALL OTHER AVIAN SPECIES EXCEPT POULTRY AND TURKEYS, CERVIDS, CAMELIDS, OR EXOTIC ANIMALS. PERMITS ARE ALSO REQUIRED ON ALL CATTLE ENTERING ARKANSAS FROM ANY STATE THAT IS NOT A TUBERCULOSIS FREE STATE, UNLESS THAT STATE HAS A RECIPROCAL AGREEMENT WITH ARKANSAS. PERMIT NUMBERS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE STATE VETERINARIAN'S OFFICE (501)907-2400 FROM 8:00 AM TO 4:30 PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY. A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION MUST ACCOMPANY ALL OUT OF STATE ANIMALS AND

- (A) MUST BE AVAILABLE ON REQUEST BY ANIMAL HEALTH OFFICIALS
- (B) INDIVIDUALLY IDENTIFY ALL ANIMALS, SHOWING POSITIVE IDENTIFICATION OF EACH ANIMAL BY TATTOO, EAR TAG, REGISTRATION NUMBER, OR EAR NOTCH. STEERS SHOULD BE IDENTIFIED BY DESCRIPTION
- (C) SHOW REQUIRED TESTS, VACCINATIONS, AND ENTRY PERMIT NUMBER, IF APPLICABLE
- (D) SHOW NAME AND ADDRESS OF OWNER/EXHIBITOR THIS SHALL BE THE SAME NAME AS UNDER WHICH ANIMALS ARE EXHIBITED
- 2. ANY ANIMAL OR POULTRY SHOWING ANY EVIDENCE OF INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASE, OR OF EXTERNAL PARASITISM, AND ANIMALS WITH ACTIVE RINGWORM LESIONS (WITH THE RESULTING LOSS OF HAIR,) MULTIPLE WARTS EASILY VISIBILE WITHOUT CLOSE EXAMINATION, OR ATROPHIC RHINITIS, WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO EXHIBIT.
- 3. ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE GROUNDS, INCLUDING THOSE SHOWN IN PETTING ZOOS, CHILDREN'S BARNYARD ANIMALS, OLD MCDONALD FARMS, ETC. MUST MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THEIR PARTICULAR SPECIES.
- 4. ALL ANIMALS ORIGINATING OUT OF AREAS QUARANTINED BECAUSE OF OTHER DISEASES (VESICULAR STOMATITIS, SCABIES, ETC.) SHALL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ENTER THE STATE

ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK

COUNTY, JR. DISTRICT, DISTRICT, STATE FAIR LEVEL, AND OTHER SHOWS

- 1. ALL ANIMALS ENTERING THE GROUNDS, INCLUDING THOSE SHOWING IN PET ZOOS, CHILDREN'S BARNYARD ANIMALS, OLD MCDONALD FARMS, ETC. MUST MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THEIR PARTICULAR SPECIES.
- 2. ARKANSAS LIVESTOCK (EXCEPT ARKANSAS SHEEP, GOATS, HORSES, STEERS, AND RABBITS) MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION ISSUED WITHIN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO EXHIBITION, SHOWING THE FOLLOWING:

ARKANSAS CATTLE

- 1. IF ARKANSAS IS A CLASS FREE STATE, ARKANSAS CATTLE ARE EXEMPT FROM BRUCELLOSIS TESTING. IF ARKANSAS IS NOT A CLASS FREE STATE, THEN THE FOLLOWING TESTING REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET: NEGATIVE BRUCELLOSIS TEST WITHIN 90 DAYS PRIOR TO EXHIBITION, FOR FEMALES AND BULLS 18 MONTHS OF AGE AND OLDER. ALL HEIFERS THAT HAVE CALVED OR ARE BRED MUST BE TESTED. ANIMALS ORIGINATING FROM A CERTIFIED BRUCELLOSIS FREE HERD ARE EXEMPT IF THE CERTIFIED FREE HERD NUMBER IS SHOWN ON CERTIFICATE.
- 2. ALL HEIFERS THAT ARE 4-12 MONTHS OF AGE SHALL BE VACCINATED BEFORE ENTERING SHOW.
- 3. HEIFERS THAT WERE BORN ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 1985, THAT ARE OVER 12 MONTHS OF AGE AND ARE NOT OFFICIAL CALFHOOD VACCINATES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW (UNLESS THEY ARE FROM A BRUCELLOSIS CERTIFIED FREE HERD)

ARKANSAS SWINE

- 1. AS OF JULY 1, 2001, ALL SWINE MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL PREMISE IDENTIFICATION
- 2. ANIMALS 6 MONTHS OLD OR OLDER TO BE TESTED NEGATIVE FOR BRUCELLOSIS WITHN 90 DAYS OF EXHIBITION OR ORIGINATE DIRECTLY OUT OF A VALIDATED HERD, WITH VALIDATION NUMBER AND DATE OF LAST HERD TEST SHOWN ON CERTIFICATE (BARROWS EXEMPT FROM BRUCELLOSIS TESTING BUT MUST BE PSEUDORABIES TESTED)
- 3. ANIMALS TO BE TESTED NEGATIVE FOR PSEUDRABIES REGARDLESS OF AGE WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE EXHIBITION ON A TEST APPROVED BY THE STATE VETERINARIAN OR ORIGINATE DIRECTLY OUT OF A QUALIFIED PSEUDORABIES FREE HERD, WITH QUALIFIED HERD NUMBER AND DATE OF LAST TEST SHOWN ON CERTIFICATE.
- 4. FREE OF OTHER CONTAGIOUS, INFECTIOUS, AND COMMUNICABLE DISEASE (ERYSIPELAS, ATROPHIC RHINITIS, ETC.)
 OTHERWISE, THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SHOW AND WILL BE RELEASED FROM FAIRGROUNDS.

ARKANSAS SHEEP AND GOATS

EXHIBITION OFFICIALS MUST MAINTAIN RECORDS OF ALL SHEEP AND GOATS THAT ARE EXHIBITED FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE

YEARS, TO INCLUDE:

- A. IDENTIFICATION NUMBER
- B. FLOCK STATUS AS DEFINED BY THE VOLUNTARY FLOCK CERTIFICATION PROGRAM
- C. THE NAME, COMPLETE ADDRESS, AND PHONE NUMBER OF OWNER

FAIR PERSONNEL, VETERINARIANS, OR STATE/FEDERAL PERSONNEL MAY EXAMINE SHEEP ON GROUNDS. ANY SHEEP SHOWING CLINICAL SYMPTOMS OF SCRAPIE SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY QUARANTINED IN ISOLATION AND REQUIRED TO UNDERGO ANY APPROVED DIAGNOSTIC TESTS AND SHALL BE CONSIGNED TO SLAUGHTER OR DESTRUCTION WITH THE SUBMISSION OF TISSUES TO AN APPROVED DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORY AT THE EXHIBITOR'S EXPENSE. COMMINGLING (AS DEFINED BY THE ARKANSAS SCRAPIE REGULATION) OF SHEEP OR GOATS OF DIFFERENT FLOCK STATUS AS DEFINED BY THE VOLUNTARY FLOCK CERTIFICATION PROGRAM (VFCP) IS PROHIBITED AND MUST BE REPORTED TO THE VFCPSTATE OFFICIAL AND STATE VETERINARIAN. NO SHEEP OR GOATS SHOWING SYMPTOM OF DISEASE, PARTICULARLY FOOT ROT, SORE MOUTH, SHEEP POX, EVIDENCE OF FUNGAL INFECTION, EVIDENCE OF ABCESSES OR WITH DRAINING

ARKANSAS RABBITS

PERSONNEL.

RABBITS WILL BE INSPECTED ON GROUNDS. NO RABBITS SHOWING SYMPTOMS OF DISEASE WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW.

ABCESSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO SHOW AND MAY BE RELEASED BY FAIR OFFICIALS, VETERINARIANS, OR STATE/FEDERAL

ARKANSAS HORSES

NEGATIVE EIA TEST REQUIRED WITHIN THE PAST 12 MONTHS FOR ALL ANIMALS OVER 6 MONTHS OF AGE. NURSING FOALS UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE ARE EXEMPT FROM TESTING IF ACCOMPANIED BY NEGATIVE TESTING DAMS. PHOTOCOPIES OF THE TEST PAPERS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. CARBON COPIES ARE ACCEPTABLE.

ARKANSAS CERVIDS

- 1. CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION
- 2. NEGATIVE CERVICAL TUBERCULOSIS TEST WITHIN 90 DAYS
- 3. NEGATIVE BRUCELLOSIS TEST WITHIN 90 DAYS
- 4. OR ORIGINATE FROM A CERTIFIED BRUCELLOSIS FREE AND ACCREDITED TUBERCULOSIS FREE CERVID HERD
- 5. OR ORIGINATE FROM A BRUCELLOSIS MONITORED AND A QUALIFIED TUBERCULOSIS CERVID HERD WITHIN 90 DAYS OF EXHIBITION

ARKANSAS RATITES

- 1. CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION
- 2. NEGATIVE AVIAN INFLUENZA TEST WITHIN 90 DAYS
- 3. PERMANENT IDENTIFICATION

ARKANSAS POULTRY

AN OFFICIAL REPRESENTING THE EXHIBITION SHALL NOTIFY THE STATE VETERINARIAN NO LATER THAN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EXHIBITION, GIVING NAMES, PLACE, INCLUSIVE DATES, AND TIME OF EVENTS THE REQUIREMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. ALL IN-STATE POULTRY, WHICH INCLUDES DOMESTICATED GAME BIRDS, QUAIL, PHEASANTS, PEAFOWL, GUINEAS, AND TURKEYS, PRESENT AT EXHIBITION IN ARKANSAS SHALL HAVE ORIGINATED FROM U.S. PULLORUM-TYPHOID CLEAN OR EQUIVALENT FLOCKS OR HAVE HAD A NEGATIVE PULLORUM-TYPHOID TEST WITHIN 90 DAYSOF THE MOVEMENT TO THE EXHIBITION (PULLORUM-TYPHOID TESTING ON FAIRGROUNDS DURING THE FAIR IS PROHIBITED.) THE INFORMATION WILL BE DOCUMENTED ON A NPIP FORM VS 9-3, 90 DAY CERTIFICATE, NPIP FLOCK CERTIFICATION FORMS OR SIMILAR CERTIFICATE WHICH WILL ACCOMPANY THE POULTRY DURING EXHIBITION.
- 2. ALL NON-CERTIFIED BIRDS MUST BE BANDED (LEG OR WING) WITH A SEALED BAND. WRAP AROUND PLASTIC BANDS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE. IN-STATE WATERFOWL ARE EXEMPT FROM PULLORUM-TYPHOID TESTING.
- 3. ANY POULTRY SHOWING EVIDENCE OF INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASE OR INSECT INFESTATION WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO EXHIBIT.
- 4. RECORD KEEPING THE SPONSOR OF THE EXHIBITION SHALL COMPILE A LIST OF ALL POULTRY PRESENT AT EXHIBITION. THE LIST SHALL CONTAIN THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH OWNER, THE NUMBER, THE SPECIES, BREED, VARIETY, TYPE, SEX, AND PULLORUM-TYPHOID STATUS OF ALL POULTRY PRESENT. A COPY OF THIS SHALL BE RETAINED BY THE SPONSOR OF THE EXHIBITION FOR AT LEAST 12 MONTHS.
