

Flea preparation sheet

Inside treatment preparation

Preparation prior to our arrival:

- Clear all floor areas of boxes, toys, and clutter. We need to have access to all floor surfaces for treatment.
- 2. Wash or dispose of pet bedding.
- 3. Vacuum flooring and rugs throughout the home & mop tile/hardwood floors.
- 4. Remove pets from home (prior to application).

After treatment is complete:

- 1. Do not clean/mop floors immediately after treatment.
- 2. Vacuum every 24 hours for a week to agitate the flea eggs encouraging them to hatch. The vacuum's vibrations and pressure will stimulate the unhatched fleas to emerge from their protective pupae cases and come in contact with the product used.
- 3. Consult veterinarian for flea treatment of all pets.
- 4. Schedule follow up treatment in 2–3 weeks.

Expect to see some adult fleas for 2–3 weeks after treatment and much smaller fleas as the eggs hatch. Flea pupae are protected from the insecticides in their cocoons. Vacuuming will help hatch the fleas to expose them to the insecticide.

Outside treatment preparation

- 1. The yard needs to be mowed prior to treatment
- 2. Remove all pet toys, kids toys, and clutter from the yard.
