There are several requirements to comply with the law. Organizations covered by PIPEDA must generally obtain an individual's consent when they collect, use, or disclose that individual's personal information. People have the right to access their personal information held by an organization. They also have the right to challenge its accuracy. Personal information can only be used for the purposes for which it was collected. If an organization is going to use it for another purpose, they must obtain consent again. Personal information must be protected by appropriate safeguards. PIPEDA applies to private-sector organizations across Canada that collect, use, or disclose personal information during a commercial activity. The law defines a commercial activity as any particular transaction, act, or conduct, or any regular course of conduct that is of a commercial character, including the selling, bartering, or leasing of donor, membership, or other fundraising lists.

Section 3. Criteria for NCPC-PAC Members

Representation from each province of Canada is the foundation of the NCPC-PAC national membership platform. The development of relationships with civil societies, businesses, Members of Parliament, Senators and government institutions throughout the country, as well as the engagement of members at the grassroots level, including but not limited to hosting local, provincial, national and international events, are important goals of the NCPC-PAC mission.

The Corporation is authorized to establish Class A members and Class B members as follow: (1) The Class A members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of the members of the Corporation and each Class A member shall have one (1) vote at each such meeting, except for meetings at which only members of another class are entitled to vote separately as a class. (2) Except as otherwise provided by the Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act, S.C. 2009, c.23 the Class B members shall not be entitled to receive notice of, attend or vote at meetings of the members of the Corporation.

Section 4. NCPC-PAC Membership Levels

1. NCPC-PAC Federal Leader (Class AB - \$750.00 CAD) "Diamond"

The Class A members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of the members of the Corporation and each Class A member shall have one (1) vote at each such meeting, except for meetings at which only members of another class are entitled to vote separately as a class. Except as otherwise provided by the Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act, S.C. 2009, c.23 the Class B members shall not be entitled to receive notice of, attend or vote at meetings of the members of the Co

Except as otherwise provided by the Canada Not-for-Profit Corporations Act, S.C. 2009, c.23 the Class B members shall not be entitled to receive notice of, attend or vote at meetings of the members of the Corporation.

3. NCPC-PAC Local Leader (Class A - \$125.00 CAD) "Gold"

The Class A members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of the members of the Corporation and each Class A member shall have one (1) vote at each such meeting, except for meetings at which only members of another class are entitled to vote separately as a class.

4. NCPC-PAC Individual (Class A - \$95.00 CAD) "Silver"

The Class A members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of the members of the Corporation and each Class A member shall have one (1) vote at each such meeting, except for meetings at which only members of another class are entitled to vote separately as a class.

5. NCPC-PAC Family Group (Class A - \$75.00 CAD) "Silver"

The Class A members shall be entitled to receive notice of and to attend all meetings of the members of the Corporation and each Class A member shall have one (1) vote at each such meeting, except for meetings at which only members of another class are entitled to vote separately as a class.

Privacy Protection Policy

The Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (PIPEDA)

An Act to support and promote electronic commerce by protecting personal information that is collected, used, or disclosed in certain circumstances, by providing for the use of electronic means to communicate or record information or transactions and by amending the Canada Evidence Act, the Statutory Instruments Act, and the Statute Revision Act.

PIPEDA applies to organizations that collect, use, or disclose personal information during commercial activities, including federal works, undertakings, and businesses. Given the nature of their activities, this would include private sector lawyers and law firms, and in many cases, their clients. Under PIPEDA, personal information includes any factual or subjective information, recorded or not, about an identifiable individual. There are several requirements to comply with the law. Organizations covered by PIPEDA must generally obtain an individual's consent when they collect, use, or disclose that individual's personal information. People have the right to access their personal information held by an organization. They also have the right to challenge its accuracy.
