You will receive a booklet of primary source documents in September, compiled specifically for the course and in an accessible weekly format. Students will also need copies of the following texts:

The Great Democracies by Winston Churchill – any edition is fine. This title is Volume IV of his series on 'A History of the English-Speaking People'. It's usually priced at £15 new and £5 second-hand.

Land of Hope: An Invitation to the Great American Story by Wilfred M. McClay – we will continue to reference this book so make sure it's still on your shelf from last year!

The Guns of August by Barbara Tuchman – ideally the Penguin version for easy page reference – ISBN: 978-0241968215 (approx. £12 new/£7 second-hand).

Preparatory Study

Please make sure your child has completed the summer term reading from the *Age of Revolution* schedule as we will discuss the Napoleonic Empire during the first lesson. It's important that they can recall those final chapters of *The Story of Modern France* so that we can review this background context effectively! They will also have covered up to the end of Chapter 12 from *Land of Hope* as part of this schedule, and it would be helpful (though not essential) to read Chapter 13 too.
