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Lesson Review Questions

Purpose: To review previous lessons and to assist children who don't attend regularly to become familiar with previous lessons.

Suggestion: Include questions from the previous week's Tracker Jr. (activities, missions, etc.) to encourage kids to do it. Reword questions to better suit the developmental age level of the children you're working with or to better fit the game/activity. They can be revised to be multiple choice, true or false, or fill in the blank. The purpose of the review questions is to reinforce what children have learned, not to stump them. Incorrect answers should always be kindly and positively corrected, so all children clearly hear the correct answer.

1. What is your favorite part of the Bible?
2. Is the Bible true? (Yes)
3. Is the Bible made up of many little books? (Yes)
4. There are two parts to your Bible, they are called the Old and New _____. (Testament)
5. When can you listen to and learn from God's Word? (Anytime)

Lesson 1

1. Who did God ask to lead the Israelites — Gideon or Bob? (Gideon)
2. Was God with Gideon? (Yes)
3. Did Gideon listen to God? (Yes)
4. What were the Midianites (bad guys) doing to the Israelites? (Stealing their food)
5. Who helped Gideon protect the Israelites from the bad Midianites? (God)
6. Is God with you wherever you go? (Yes)

Lesson 2

1. What was the name of the man who was very strong — John or Samson? (Samson)
2. Was Samson strong because he obeyed God by not eating candy or not cutting his hair? (He obeyed God by not cutting his hair)
3. Did Samson fall in love with Delilah or Eve? (Delilah)
4. Did Delilah love God? (No)
5. What secret did Delilah want Samson to tell her? (The secret to his strength)
6. Did Samson disobey God and sin? (Yes)
7. Does God hate sin? (Yes)
8. What happened to Samson after Delilah cut his hair? (He lost his strength)

Lesson 3

1. What made Naomi very sad? (Her husband and two sons died)
2. Why did Ruth go to Israel with Naomi? (She loved God, and she loved Naomi)
3. Who did Boaz help? (Ruth)
4. What did Naomi want Ruth and Boaz to do? (Get married)
5. What did God give to Ruth and Boaz? (A baby boy)
6. Who can you love this week?

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Lesson 4

1. Why was Hannah sad? (She couldn't have a baby)
2. Did Hannah obey God when she was sad? How? (Yes, she prayed to God)
3. Did God hear Hannah when she prayed? (Yes)
4. What did Hannah say she would do if God gave her a son? (She promised to bring her son back to the temple to serve God)
5. Did God give Hannah a baby boy? (Yes)
6. Did Hannah keep her promise to God? How? (Yes, when Samuel was old enough, she took him to the temple where he could serve God)
7. Does God hear you when you pray? (Yes!)

Lesson 5

1. Where did Samuel live? (In the temple)
2. Who was the priest in God's temple? (Eli)
3. Were Eli and his two sons obedient or disobedient to God? (Disobedient)
4. Did God speak to Samuel? (Yes)
5. How does God usually speak to people? (Through the Bible)
6. Did Samuel obey God when God spoke to him? (Yes)
7. Should you obey what God tells you in the Bible? (Yes)

Lesson 6

1. Did the Israelites want a man to be their king? (Yes)
2. After Samuel gave them a warning from God, did they change their minds? (No)
3. What did God do when the Israelites still wanted a king? (He gave them a king)
4. Who was Israel's first king? (Saul)
5. Do you think the Israelites made a good choice or a bad choice when they chose to do things their way instead of God's way? (It was a bad choice)
6. Will you do things your way or God's way?

Lesson 7

1. Who was the first King of Israel — Henry or Saul? (Saul)
2. Did King Saul put God first or was he selfish? (He was very selfish and only thought of himself)
3. How do we know he was very selfish? (He made a statue of himself and took things that didn't belong to him)
4. What decision did God make when King Saul did not obey Him? (Saul could not be the king anymore because he wouldn't obey)
5. How does God want us to obey Him? (God wants us to not be selfish and put ourselves first, but to put Him first)

Lesson 8

1. Samuel went to Bethlehem to find a new _____? (King)
2. Which one of Jesse's sons did God choose to be the next king? (David)
3. Was David the oldest or youngest son? (Youngest)
4. What was David doing when Jesse and his other sons met with Samuel? (He was taking care of the sheep)
5. Did David love and obey God? (Yes)
6. Did David have to wait to become king, or did he become king right away? (He had to wait)
7. Does God know everything about you? (Yes)

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Lesson 9

1. What was the name of the giant Philistine soldier — Tom or Goliath? (Goliath)
2. What did Goliath want to do? (He wanted to hurt the Israelites)
3. Who was the only one willing to fight Goliath? (David)
4. Why was David so sure he could fight Goliath? (David obeyed and trusted God alone to make him the winner)
5. Who fought with heavy armor, a huge spear, a sword, and a shield bearer? (Goliath)
6. Who fought with his shepherd's staff, a slingshot with five stones, and God? (David)
7. Who was the winner of the fight? (God made David the winner!)
8. Because we know God is super strong and He is our strength, can you trust and obey Him?

OT or NT?

Purpose: To challenge children to think about where the individual lessons are found in the Bible – the Old Testament or the New Testament.
