Summer Intern Job Descriptions

CONSTRUCTION INTERN- This intern will be responsible for coordinating construction projects in the community and at the Wade Center.

Responsibilities:

- Create long-lasting relationships with the missionaries and other interns.
- Taking applications from local home owners for home improvements and communicating with homeowners to answer any questions.
- Work closely with mission teams to coordinate their experience and expertise to do construction jobs.
- Have knowledge and skill of doing home repair projects such as, painting, roof work, yard work, cleaning, patching holes, and other basic repairs.
- Work on repairs and assist with maintenance at the Wade Center.
- Pick up necessary materials to complete home repairs.
- Lead skilled and unskilled team in completing repairs and construction.
- Assist the Wade Center in recruiting skilled volunteers.
