Wayne Adams called the meeting to order. Upon motion made by Herman Williams and seconded by Herman Munster the minutes of the November meeting were unanimously approved.

Al Carter told the Board that the meeting for the Hall of Honor inductee selection would be held on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 at 3:00 PM in the all purpose meeting room at South Houston High School. Al also noted that 2025 would be the 50th anniversary of the football season of the Junkyard Dogs. That anniversary might be an opportunity to organize a reunion to honor the team’s members. There might be a possibility of a half time presentation at the 2025 Homecoming game.

Herman Williams then presented a report from the Nominating Committee. Herman noted that the Board currently has two vacancies following the resignation of Robert Marquez. Denise Ball Carter indicated an interest in serving but has not responded to Herman’s contact. Luci Fuller indicated she would send a message to Denis from her personal Facebook page. It was noted that Natalie Viera has not attended any Board meetings. It was recommended that she be removed from the Board after the appropriate notification.

Wayne Adams discussed changes to the Alumni website indicating that the basketball tournament information could be replaced with the results from the competitions. The Board noted that South Houston High School teams, both boys and girls, performed well in the tournament. There was a discussion regarding the promotion of commemorative bricks for the holiday season and it was recommended that the current version of the brick directory be accessible on the website.

Wayne Adams reminded the Board members that Thursday, December 12th, 2024 would be the annual Prize Parade conducted by the Pasadena ISD Education Foundation. Those attending should assemble at the Pasadena ISD Administration Bldg at 8:00 am. Prize distribution will be followed by lunch provided by ther Culinary Arts students of Dobie High School.

Luci Fuller then inquired about the last Alumni project. Wayne Adams noted that the purchase of a new run through for the football team had been the last project to which the Alumni Association had provided funding. The Board then had a discussion about other potential projects. Wayne Adams then suggested that the Association might want to create a fund designed to help students with financial assistance for extra-curricular activities. He suggested that engaging assistance at the school level would be important.
