Wayne Adams and called the meeting to order.

Upon motion made by Herman Munster and seconded by Jose Rosales, the minutes of the meeting of April 8, 2025 were unanimously approved.

Bruce Summers presented a financial report of the Association’s position. Upon motion made by Herman Williams and seconded by Neal Cooper, the financial report was approved.

Wayne Adams gave the president’s report. He reminded the Board that Principal Andrea Wenke would be retiring at the end of the 2024-2025 school year. The Board had agreed at the last meeting to present Mrs. Wenke with a greeting card and Visa gift card in appreciation for all her support of the Alumni Association.

Wayne also shared that Jennifer Stewart would be assuming the role of Principal at South Houston High School. Wayne indicated that the Board would need to request a meeting with Principal Stewart to provide her with background on the Alumni Association and its efforts to preserve the history of the school.

Wayne also told the Board that in addition to the appointment of Jennfer Stewart, South Houston’s Coach Longstreet has been appointed as the District’s Athletic Director.

Herman Williams reported that there a possible candidate for service on the Board, Bernardo Aldape, Class of 2000 and graduate of UT Austin and Thurgood Marshal Law School, is an attorney and former presiding judge. Herman opined that Bernardo’s life experience would be a valuable addition to the Board’s skill set. Herman also indicated that Luci Fuller had indicated a possibility of stepping back from the active Board due to conflicts which scheduling. Wayne Adams will contact Luci to discuss her wishes and recommended that she move to the Advisory Board.

Ricki Willoughby provided a review of updates to the Alumni website. Ricki indicted that now that the date for Homecoming has been announced a “Save the Date” email blast could be sen out. The Board discussed the logistics of trying to locate team members of the 1975 football team known as the Junkyard Dogs. Wayne Adams will contact Wes Hubert to determine if he has some contact information.

Herman Williams provided an update on the status of commemorative brick orders.

The Board then discussed the options for commemorating the 50th anniversary of the 1975 football season and those team members it might be able to locate.

Wayne Adams indicated he would contact Principal Stewart at the first available opportunity to discuss the future of the Alumni Association as well as the Hall of Honor and Museum.

Wayne also reminded the Board that Homecoming is scheduled for Friday, October 10, 2025. He expects the days activities to be similar to the prior years schedule and setup. He asked Claudia Lively to contact Sudie's regarding a meet and greet .

Lastly, Wayne proposed that the next schedule meeting of the Board be held on Tuesday, August 12, 2025.
