Wayne Adams called the meeting to order.

Upon motion made by Herman Williams and seconded by Gayle Holder the minutes of the meeting of January 14, 2025 were unanimously approved.

The Board then discussed filling in the two available Director positions. Johnny Fusilier recommended Leslie Hinojsa, Class of 2000. The Board also discussed adding Joy Denise Carter, Class of 1980, to the board. It was noted that both individuals have strong skills and an interest in participating on the Board. Upon motion made by Herman Williams and seconded by Bruce Summers, Leslie Hinojosa and Joy Denise Carter were appointed to the Board of Directors.

The Alumni website has been updated with information about the upcoming Pasadena ISD Athletics Hall of Fame banquet. Wayne Adams provided a flyer for use in promoting the event and providing ticket information.

Herman Williams stated that there had been no new activity for commemorative bricks. The Board agreed that a promotion prior to the annual meeting would be the logical fund-raising effort.

The Board then discussed the possibility of memorializing the Junkyard Dogs, member of the 1975 football season in which SHHS went all the way to District competition. The Board would like to include as many players and coaches as possible. Ricki Willoughby agreed to contact Denise Carter who had volunteered to try to locate some of the players. Bruce Summers indicated he might be able to determine which classmate organizes the Class of 1976 reunions and obtain some team member information that way.

Al Carter then shared the results of the committee meeting to select the 2025 Hall of Honor alumni and faculty. Al indicated he had been in touch with inductees or family members, if deceased, to determine their willingness to attend the ceremony at Homecoming. Al reminded the Board of the preparations needed to make the event go smoothly. The Board confirmed that the co-chairs of the Homecoming Committee would be Luci Fuller and Ricki Willoughby.

The Board received a funding request from the Director of the Janettes which would assist that team in offsetting a fund-raising cost. The request for funding was approved upon motion by Ricki Willoughby and second by Gayle Holder.

The Board then discussed the Annual Meeting and selected Thursday April 17th, 2025 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm as the date and time. Since Mrs. Wenke will be retiring at the end of the 24-25 school year, Wayne Adams suggested honoring her at the Annual Meeting in recognition of her support of the Alumni Association.

Upon motion made by Herman Williams and seconded by Ricki Willoughby, the Board approved an expense to provide offset frame mounts to add class panorama photos to those already displayed in the school halls.

Upon motion made by Ricki Willoughby and seconded by Jose Rosales, the Board unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting.
