## PARTICIPATION IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

Union County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) have entered into a

joint and coordinated effort.

WHEREAS,

the total cost of the project will be \$164,667.00 to be funded in proportional share by the parties

hereto as follows:

a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$123,500.00

and

b. Union County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$41,167.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$164,667.00

Union County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$\$164,667.00

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED in official session that Union County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on December 31, 2023 and Union County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY UNION COUNTY, to enter into Cooperative Agreement Control #L400590 with the NMDOT for LGRF project for year terminating on December 31, 2023

Plan design, construction management, construction, reconstruction, pavement rehab, drainage improvements, and miscellaneous to various county roads.
