At 9:02 a.m., Chairman Kiesling called the meeting to order in the Commission Chambers located in the Union County Administration Building. The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Commissioner Miller moved to approve the agenda and the regular meeting minutes of September 12, 2023. Commissioner Vincent seconded. There was no further discussion. Vote: ALL AYE. The minutes were signed.

HOSPITAL REPORT

Tammie Stump, CEO, reported on statistics for September. Before the meeting, the "County Commissioner Monthly Hospital Report, Union County General Hospital, Tammie Stump, CEO, October 10, 2023", was distributed to the board. Items covered included the following (but not limited to the following): Provider Recruitment Update; Financial Assistance/Compliance Update; Business/Financial Update; Compliance; Radiology; Plant Services; Therapy Services; Pharmacy; Laboratory; Union County/Des Moines Health Centers; IT; HVAC/Vestibule/Cryogenic Tank 3000 gallon/Grade Survey; PL/GL Insurance Coverage.

Due to time constraints, Melissa Prante, CFO, did not report on financials for August. Before the meeting, the "Clayton Health Systems, Inc. Statistics on services provided by Apollo and Rico were reviewed by the board.

Commissioner Vincent moved to direct the County Manager to proceed with the contract process with Apollo as the flight membership provider for Union County residents. Commissioner Miller seconded. There was no further discussion. VOTE: ALL AYE. Motion carried.

Possible uses of the ARPA funding received by the county was discussed. This item will continue to be an agenda item for future meetings.

COUNTY MANAGER REPORT

Mgr. Thompson gave an overview of a recent conversation with Golden Spread regarding their request to have Union County act as fiscal agent for possible government funding of a proposed assisted living facility. Further research is needed as to the feasibility of such an agreement.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT

Mgr. Thompson reported on behalf of Road Superintendent Wright, and gave an update on various road projects.

FIRE COORDINATOR/EMERGENCY MANAGER REPORT

Emergency manager Kris Lawrence reported he will be attending the New Mexico Fire Chiefs Academy next week.

ELECTED OFFICIALS REPORTS

Assessor Sandoval reported the tax rolls will be transferred to the Treasurer's office tomorrow so they can begin preparing tax bills.

Clerk Green reported that early voting started today, and an election integrity advertising campaign that she participated in will start running on PBS and other outlets soon.

Sheriff Skaggs reported he will be attending the Grenville Village meeting tonight to discuss the possible donation of a vehicle to the Grenville EMS.

Chairman Kiesling shared his appreciation of the presentation on fentanyl at the NMC Board meeting in Socorro.
