If your claim of exemption is denied, you may either seek approval of a subdivision or appeal the denial as provided in, the Union County Subdivision Regulations.

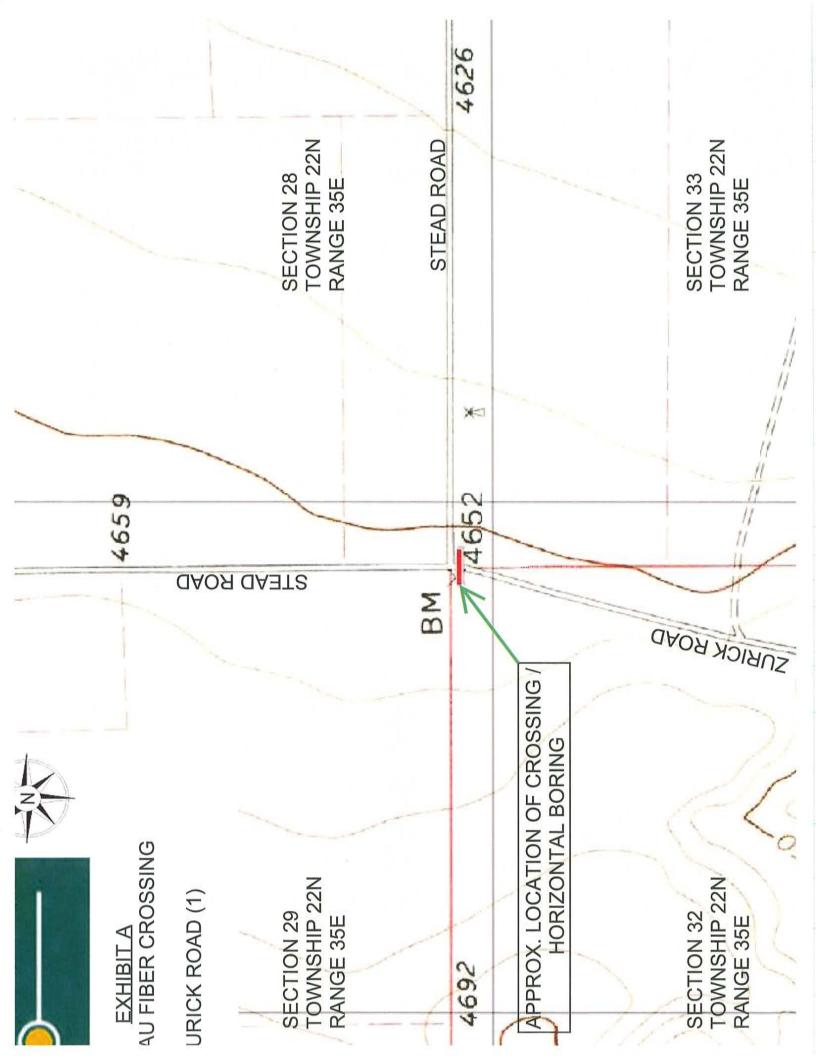

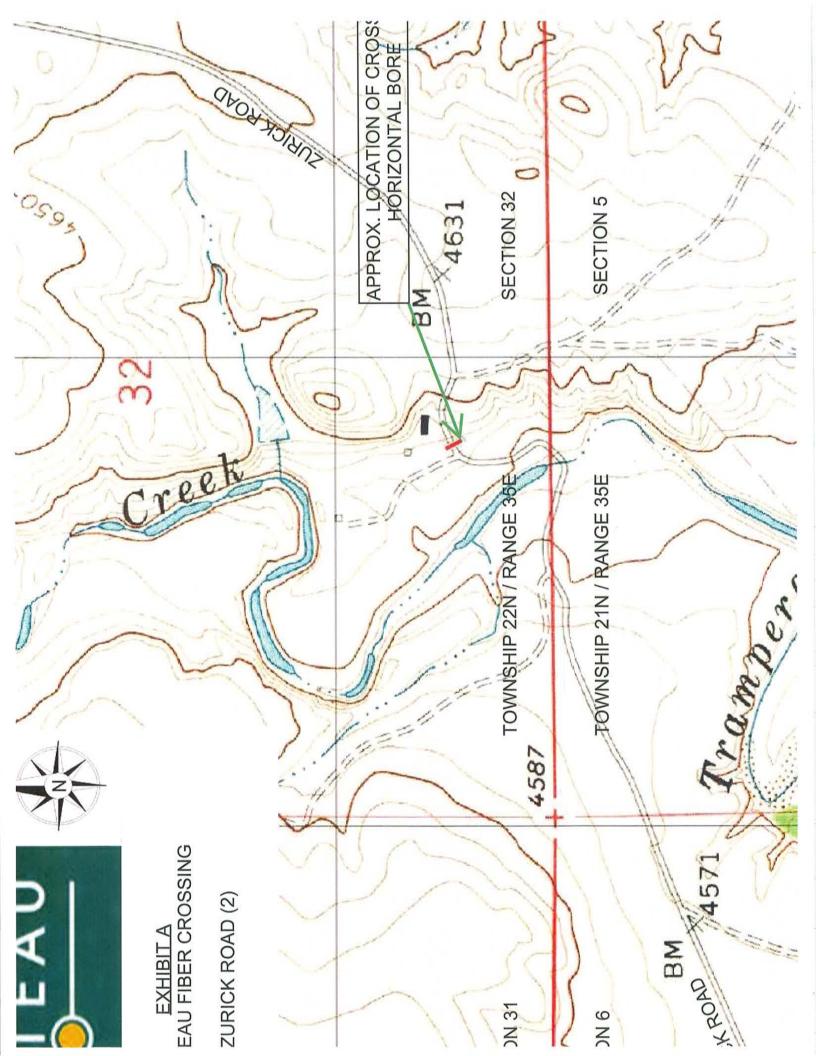

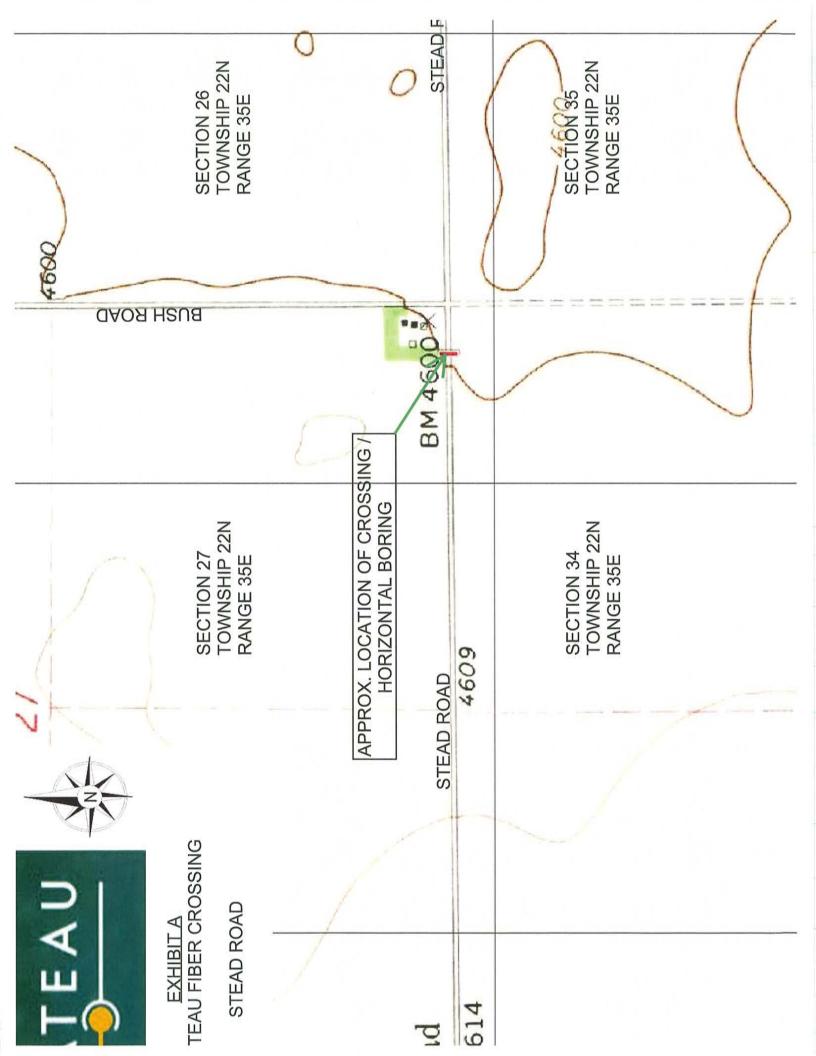
