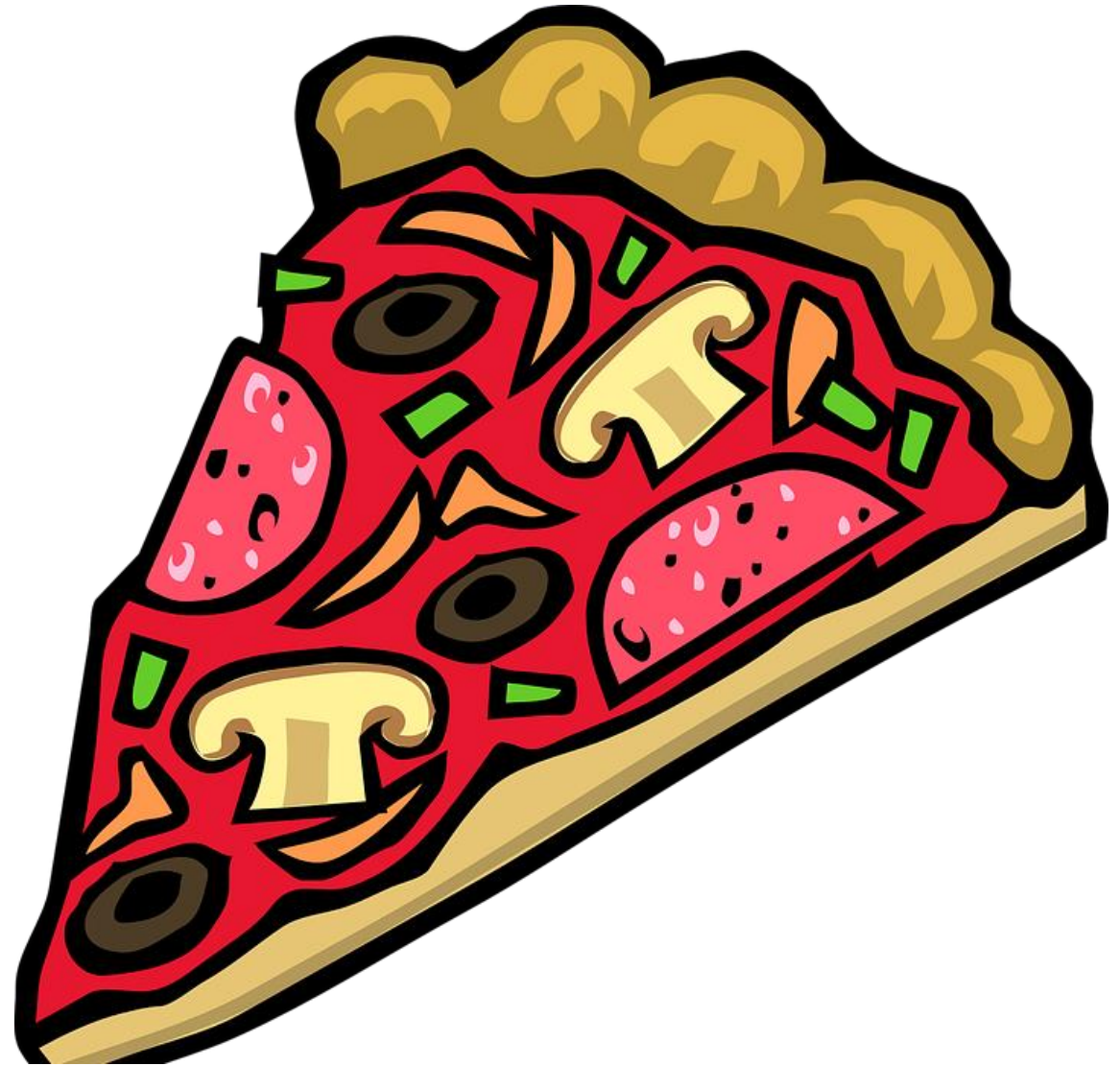

History Of Horse Back Riding

The history of horseback riding timeline usually goes back to central Asia about five centuries or so before the appearance of cavalry in armies of Middle East around 1000 B.C. But new evidence based on dental wear caused by a bit in a prehistoric horse indicates that riding began much earlier.

- Horses can sleep both lying down and standing up.
- Horses can run shortly after birth.
- Domestic horses have a lifespan of around 25 years.
- A 19th century horse named 'Old Billy' is said to have lived 62 years.
- Horses have around 205 bones in their skeleton.
- Horses have been domesticated for over 5000 years.
