Since 1811, Santa Sofia winery has been crafting stunning wines at the historic Palladian Villa, Sarego, a UNESCO world heritage site. Under the stewardship of winemaker Giancarlo Begnoni and his son Luciano, the forces of tradition and innovation combine, making Santa Sofia one of the most iconic names in Venetian winemaking. The 2021 Garda Le Calderare Pinot Grigio entices with a harmonious nose of delicate bergamot, citrus, and tropical notes mirrored on a mineral tinged palate that quenches with hints of salinity, lime, and dried herbs.
