Since 1811, Santa Sofia winery has been crafting stunning wines at the historic Palladian Villa, Sarego, a UNESCO world heritage site. Under the stewardship of winemaker Giancarlo Begnoni and his son Luciano, the forces of tradition and innovation combine, making Santa Sofia one of the most iconic names in Venetian winemaking. The 2023 Montefoscarino Soave Classico is a fresh expression with a backbone of classic Soave minerality underpinning juicy stone fruit, white flowers, ripe citrus, and a hint of fresh herbs leading into a long, clean finish.
