What is required to become a Certified Pilot?

Many instructors and flight schools will try to “sugar- coat” the answer; I won’t. Short answer: A lot of time, money and effort. Still interested? Then read on.

Your piloting skills will be taught by **Certified Flight Instructor (CFI) William Herrmann**. I have over 2700 flight hours and 800+ Instructor hours. I am an independent Flight Instructor. I teach flying because I enjoy it. I carry only three students at any given time.

How long will it take to become a Pilot?

Short answer: At least nine months.

The one factor that can significantly accelerate training is how frequently the student pilot can take flight lessons. I only accept clients who can commit to at least one lesson per week.

What kind of airplane will I be flying?

A **Cessna 172R**, the workhorse of flight schools worldwide.

O.K. How do I get started?

I offer a **\$140 Introductory Flight**. This flight is 45 minutes in duration (preceded by a 30 minute Safety Briefing). Other than the landing, you will actually fly the plane.

The Intro Flight is an excellent way to determine if flying a small General Aviation aircraft is right for you.
