BURN PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must have street address posted in visible location (numbers at least 4" tall)
- **2**. Must have **constant supervision** while burning.
- 3. Wind speed must be less than 10 miles per hour.
- 4. Must have water under pressure.
- 5. Burning during daylight hours only, sunrise to sunset.
- 6. Burning must be contained no less than 50 feet from any structure, or if in an approved waste burner, no less than 15 feet from any structure.
- 7. Open burning of the following is **PROHIBITED:** plastic, waste petroleum products, hazardous materials, tar paper, poison oak, asbestos, poison ivy, poison sumac, oleanders, aerosol spray cans, flammable liquids, explosives or ammunition, polyester, thermal insulation, tires, electric wire insulation, batteries, hazardous waste products, asphalt shingles.
- **8**. If you are unable to burn within the calendar month, you can request another permit for the next calendar month.

9. The burn permit applicant shall call the fire department BEFORE and AFTER Burn at 928-767-3300.

If burning in piles, they can be no more than 3 feet by 4 feet.

Permits will be validated between the hours of 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Friday at the Lake Mohave Ranchos Fire District Administration office located at 16126 Pierce Ferry Rd., Dolan Springs, AZ

NO burning allowed during periods of high fire danger as established by the AZ State Forestry Dept.

Firefighting resources are extremely limited here in our remote desert location. Please respect the burn requirements for all our safety and well-being.
