TAP SHOES

For younger age groups tap shoes must be white (black for boys only) as this is the requirement for exams. The tap shoes should NOT have heel taps on them as these are not allowed until the pupils have passed Grade 2 Tap. The white tap shoes can be canvas or pvc, tie up or Velcro. These are usually the same size as school shoes and should not slip off the back of the foot.

Tie up - Canvas, no heel tap



Canvas or PVC with heel tap are not allowed

Once pupils have passed Grade 2, Teletones (this is a make of taps that sound better when tapping) are required along with heel taps. These tap shoes are black leather. The best makes for these are **Capezio** or **Bloch**. Leather is best, allowing the children's feet to breath and softer for better movement of the feet.
