At ALL levels of Extra Help:

1. Extra help/LIS PAYS monthly premiums -up to the benchmark for each state (chart below). This means if the client keeps their LIS in 2025, it reduces plan premiums by the amount below. Income and resource limits will change some in 2025. If they lose LIS, they have a SEP during which they can choose another plan.

2. Extra help/LIS eliminates the plan's drug deductible.

3. Extra Help/LIS recipients pay either the co-pay from the chart below based on income level, or the co-pay from the plan, whichever is lower.

4. Remember that for a drug to be covered at all, it must be on the formulary for that plan, unless the plan approves a formulary exception.
