**Presentation by Pat Crawford, videography by Donna Crawford.**

Rick Budd introduced Pat and acknowledged Pat and his wife Donna had done all the research and videography for the presentation.

Pat jumped right in and played his video, <https://youtu.be/g7Y87ltClMo> (if the hyperlink is broken cut and paste the link into your browser) of him making bowls (round and square) without a lathe. The video is broken into the many steps to make the bowls from pattern making, cutting the various layer on either a scroll saw or band saw, gluing the various layers and finally sanding and finishing the bowls.


Spruce finials
