SUNCOAST WOODCRAFTERS GUILD GENERAL MEETING MINUTES October 18, 2022 at 7:00 PM Chatelech Secondary School Library 5904 Cowrie Street, Sechelt, BC.

MEETING PROGRAM: "Group Discussion on Wood Finishing" lead by Rick Budd

Rick acknowledged Bob Marando, one of our Guild members, had suggested the topic. Members had been asked to bring some of their favourite products and samples of applied finishes and share their challenges, solutions and experiences.

Rick began the session showing a 17 minute YouTube video by Michael Alm, from Seattle titled "Choosing the Right Wood Finish for your Project" https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bUQXqvUkbsY.

Rick and the Education Committee had reviewed the video and thought it to be the best they could find on the subject. Everyone seemed to agree after watching the video. One of the many take-aways from the video was; regardless of the finishing product, sanding (material prep. (machine and then by hand) was most important to a good finish! The video also covered staining, top coating, shop safety (respirators & air filtration systems), spray systems, oils, waxes (including food safety) and outdoor finishes.

To begin the open discussion Rick ran through the products and sample finishes he brought as follows;

- o Copy of Gift/Toy Guidelines attached.


CORRESPONDENCE AND NEW BUSINESS:
