# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USA EQ. USEF. Rule Book and the rule books of each association that recognizes this show. This show will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In all classes wherein the rules of the USEF do not apply, the show committee shall settle any dispute or question that my arise an the decision will be final. Exhibitors and other participants herein, as a condition of admission, shall consent to such methods of settlement. USA Equestrian USEF Rule XIV. Chapter 1, Article 1401, 8 states:

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

#### **Federation Entry Agreement**

By entering a Federation Competition and signing an entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents. I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation" and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the competition my use of assign photographs, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my hose taken during the course of competition for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the competition, sport or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise product and they may not be used in such a way to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be files in New York State. See GR908.4

WARNING: Under Iowa law, a domesticated animal professional is not liable for damages suffered by, an injury to, or the death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of domesticated animal activities pursuant to Iowa Code Chapter 673. You are assuming inherent risks of participating in this domesticated animal activity.

Championships, Ribbons, and Trophies: Ribbons will be awarded to eight places in all classes. In all full sections all classes award full points towards champion and reserve champion placings. Championship trophy and ribbon, reserve champion ribbon to be awarded in all sections in accordance with USEF rules. Jumper ties for other than first place will remain tied and the prize money will be divided equally among the ties; ribbon placement will be handled by the toss of a coin.

**Liability/ Loss/ Injury:** Valley Park Stables and its affiliates, owners, employees, committee members, show officials or agents will not be responsible or liable for any injury sustained in any way to horses, exhibitors, spectators or employees. Nor will any of the above named persons be responsible for any

article of any kind or nature that may be lost, destroyed or stolen. The management also reserves the right to remove from the grounds any stable - its staff or personnel - exhibitor, horse, or spectator which management deems fit in the best interest of the show without being held liable for damages of any kind. The jumps and courses in any or all classes are subject to change at the discretion of the show committee - in case of a jump-off, accident to equipment, or for any other reason the above statements shall be accepted and agreed to as a condition of entry.

**ENTRIES** must be properly made on the official entry blank, signed as required, and must be accompanied by a check or money order covering entry, stall and drug fees. Make checks or money orders payable to Valley Park Horse Show. Entries postmarked on or before **July 19** which contain the stall fee per horse and a \$25 deposit per horse (both are non-refundable fees) will NOT be assessed a late entry fee. The deposit fee is to be subtracted from the entry fees at show time. Entries postmarked after July 19 WILL BE considered late entries and a \$25 per horse late fee will be added to the entry fees. \*\*Entries dropped off in the Valley Park Stables office on or before July 19 will not be considered late.

DOGS: Please - for everyone's health, welfare and sanity, we ask you to control your dogs with a leash.

MEMBERSHIP, MEASUREMENT & AMATEUR CARDS: All participants (riders, owners, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copy thereof, or he/she must pay \$45(USEF) and \$30 (USHJA) non-member fee. All junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the show office, a current USEF measurement card or be measured on the grounds. All amateur owners and adult amateurs must also present amateur certification. To speed processing, please enclose copies of card with your entry.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES: Methodist Hospital (Level 1 Trauma center) is the closest hospital to Valley Park and is 1.6 Miles away.

HORSE IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunt seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A Registration Number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

MICRO CHIPPING Beginning in the 2019 competition year, all horses competing in USEF-licensed and /or USHJA sacntioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper, and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breeed will be required to be micro chipped. USEF has provided education materials to competitors to learn more about microchipping and the rules (HU101, JP100, EQ103). At competitions, exhibitors may ask to turn in a USEF Microchip Reporting Form. Please let them know they can report the microchip number directly to USEf three ways: 1. Onlineby signing in to therir My USEF My Way account and updating the horse's record. 2. Faxing to (859) 231-6662 or emailing to <a href="https://docs.press.org/licenses/buses/buses/">horseservices@USEF.org</a> the Microchip Reporting Form, which may be used to report chip numbers for mulitiple horses. 3. Completing the microchip field on a USEF horse Recoring/ ID Application. The c completion and submission of this form is the sole responsibility of the competitior. Competitions are not responsible for assisting with the forms. Our office will check the form to ensure accuracy and completeness once received.

STABLING\*\*\*\*LIMITED STALLS\*\*\*\*Entries received after the closing date of July 19 will possibly not have a stall on the grounds. Please call Ned Long (515)231-with a stall count as soon as possible. Group must be named on entry blank - otherwise the group will be scattered and a tack stall will not be available. Stabling will be in metal temporary stalls with a front. First bedding not included. Hay and bedding will be available for purchase.

SCHOOLING. As always, there is no charge for schooling. All riders must wear proper hard hats when mounted. Tuesday is open schooling from 10:00am-7:00pm. Wednesday through Sunday schooling until 1 hour prior to start. Schooling in the jumper arena will be allowed, but may be limited. \*\* We will limit the number of horses allowed in the ring in order to maintain safety.

GOLFCARTS, ETC: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Short Stirrup for riders who have not reached their 12th birthday who have not won six first place ribbons at any USEF show that exceed 2'6", no cross entry in classes requiring entry to jump 3' or higher or in Long Stirrup; fences 2'3". Long Stirrup Open to junior or amateur riders who have not won 3 first place ribbons at any USEF/CEF recognized show over fences which exceed 2'6" in height in the past 3 years, including equitation. A rider who is eligible as of December 1 shall retain his/her eligibility throughout the year. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Combinations prohibited. Amateurs may not cross enter in a class where fences exceed 2'9". Juniors may not cross enter in a class where fences exceed 3'. No cross entry in Short Stirrup Eq/ Hunter

Riders will first be required to show over a course of not less than 8 obstacles of which 6 must be set at the maximum height. The course must include one change of direction and one combination including an oxer. The judge shall select a minimum of 8 riders, if available, from the over fences section to show back in the flat section. In the flat section, riders shall be shown as a group at the walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. No martingales allowed in the flat phase. The judge may ask for tests 1-19 of the top 4 riders. One rider per horse. All eligible INHJA members may enter this class at each INHJA approved show. Medals awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd; ribbons to 8th.

Offered at 2'6 or 2'9: Open to all junior and amateur riders who although only current members of INHJA will accue year-end championship points. Riders will first be required to show over a course of not less than eight obstacles. The course must include one change of direction. The judge shall select a minimum of eight riders, if available, from the over fences section to show back in the flat section. In the flat section, riders shall be shown as a group at the walk, trot and canter both directions of the ring. No martingales allowed in the flat phase. The judge may ask for tests 1-13 of the top 4 riders. Only one rider per horse. All eligible INHJA members may enter this class at each INHJA approved show, regardless of previous wins. Medals awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd; ribbons to 8th.

# **HUNTER DIVISION**

Hunters under saddle are to be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Light contact with the horse's/pony's mouth is required. Horses/ponies should be obedient, alert, responsive and move freely and not be eliminated for slight errors. Horses/ponies may be asked to hand gallop collectively one way of the ring, at the judge's discretion, but never more than eight at one time. Green, Pre-Green, lowa Nebraska Novice, Children's and novice (including short and long stirrup) classes will not be asked. UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED ALL ENTRIES JUDGED ON PERFORMANCE, SOUNDNESS, MANNERS AND WAY OF GOING. Conformation not to be considered, except percentage stated per class. Fences shall simulate obstacles found in the hunting field such as natural post and rails, brush, chicken coup, gate and logs. To be judged on performance and soundness.

# ALL DAY WARM-UPS

Class Entry Fee \$30.00

Open to all exhibitors. The gate will allow rider to designate before entry into the ring that he/she is riding a warm-up round. Fence heights to be in conjunction with various sections during the day. Horses may complete multiple warm-up rounds for an additional entry fee. Only first round will be judged. Warm-up may be cancelled or closed in the interest of time.
