

3v3 Tournament Rules and Format

1. Home team will shoot for ball at the start of each game. (They are the team listed first on the schedule)
2. Each game will be to 21 points or 15 minutes long. The team must win by only one point.
3. Teams score by either regular two-point baskets, or by three-point shots taken from outside the three-point circle.
4. After a basket has been scored or any dead ball situation, a player must put the ball in play from a line past the three-point line above the foul key with a standard "check ball". Ball must be passed in to start the possession, players cannot dribble immediately after the check.
5. All jump balls will be put into play behind the three-point line with possession given alternately to each team.
6. On defensive rebounds or steals, players must return the ball by dribble or pass across the three point line before a basket may be attempted. Once across the line, they do not have to pass the ball before shooting.
7. Fouls will be called by the court referees. A foul called in the act of shooting will result in either two or three points being awarded to the team which was fouled, depending on where the player was fouled and a change of possession. A non-shooting foul will result in the award of one point to the offended team and the ball back.
8. However, once a team reaches 15 points they will be in the bonus. Every foul committed against the offense will result in free throws.
9. A foul called in the act of shooting will result in either two or three free throws awarded to the team, which was fouled, depending on where the player was fouled. A non-shooting foul will result in one free throw to the offended team. All free-throws will have players lined up in the lane lines and play live one release.
10. The three-second rule will apply to all offensive players.
11. Substitutions may be made after a basket or any dead ball situation.
12. Each team is only allowed one 30-second timeout, but the clock only stops if it is used under the last minute of play.
13. If the game ends in a tie after regulation there will be a one minute overtime period. Possession will be determined by the home team shooting for ball.
14. Ties at the end of any overtime period will result in successive one-minute periods until the tie has been broken, with possession alternating each overtime period.

- Team Roster - Coach must complete and submit a HOH Team Roster Form, per team, prior to first game; Coach may make changes to the roster through Week 3 of league. Coach must possess and be prepared to present proof of eligibility for every player upon roster submission.
- Protests - Coaches must file protests against suspected ineligible players **prior to** start of game. HOH staff only will handle protests. All protests require a non-refundable \$50 fee
- Game ball will be provided by the home team
 - Game Ball Sizes
 - Boys & Girls K–2rd Grade — size 27.5
 - Girls 3rd Grade–Varsity & Boys 3rd–6th Grade — size 28.5
 - Boys 7th Grade–Varsity — size 29.5

Entry Fee: Daily Pass - \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students (1st -12th).

- Coaches - one coach per team will be admitted free with Coach's ID/stamp.

Coaches Responsibilities

1. Coaches must write in roster prior to game time at the scores table
2. If a coach decides to challenge an opposing player's grade eligibility, all challenges must take place BEFORE start of game and brought to the site director's attention.
 1. Coaches must be able to provide proof of a player's grade eligibility by providing either a report card, progress report, class schedule or current school ID AND a player's birth certificates or state ID. If a coach is unable to provide proof of a player's grade and age, or it is determined the player is not eligible - ALL GAMES THE PLAYER PARTICIPATED IN WILL BE VACATED.

Zero Tolerance Policy

1. PLAYERS CAN NOT PLAY ON MULTIPLE TEAMS WITHIN THE SAME DIVISION
2. If any of the following occurs, individuals will be subject to removal of the event for the day:
 - Heckling of officials by coaches, players, parents and all other spectators
 - Fighting by anyone including officials, coaches, players, parents and spectators
 - Threatening acts or gestures by officials, players, coaches, or spectators
3. House of Hoops reserves the right to take any or all of the following actions:
 - Removal from the game
 - Forfeiture of the game
 - Expulsion from future events
 - Law enforcement involvement
4. All decisions from the League Director are FINAL

COVID Compliance

To meet state-mandated venue load limits for the purpose of better protecting patrons from the COVID threat, games will be controlled to last no more than one hour each from scheduled start time. We will perform sanitation of player benches, spectator bleachers and game equipment. We ask that those who are unvaccinated to please wear a mask. It is encouraged for those who are vaccinated to also wear a mask, but it is not required.
