

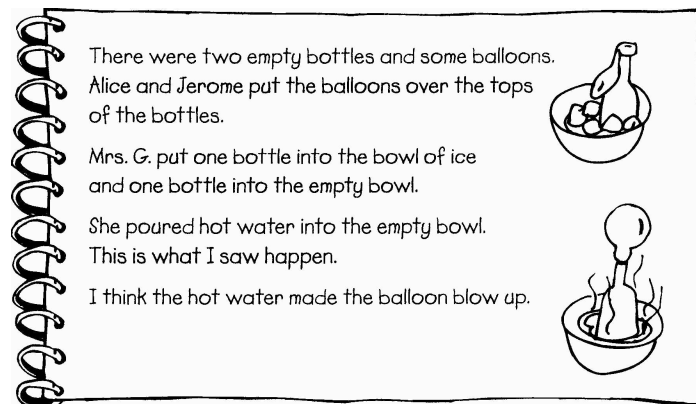
## Science Shorts -6

### Phil's Science Log

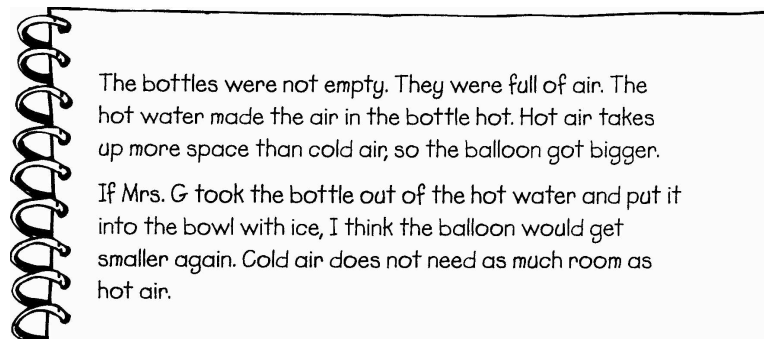
