## What To Do:

On the front of each Project Sheet make a food web using the Organisms Sheet using the following rules:

## Rules for Food Chains/Food Webs

1. Start with the producer.
2. Determine where the energy from the producer is flowing.
3. Determine where the energy from each consumer is flowing.
4. Draw the arrows in the direction the energy is flowing.
5. End with a decomposer.
6. Place more organisms within the food chain to make a Food Web.
2. On the back of the Project Sheet fill in the charts with information about the relationships within the Food Web.
3. Wait to fill in the Parasite/Host chart until after the next lesson.
4. Be sure to glue the parasite near its host and draw the arrow in the direction the energy flows.
