

RIO BERMEJO – ARGENTINA DORADO & CATFISH



Argentina offers, by far, the best fishing in South America, but has remained under the radar for most overseas anglers until the last decade, or so. Now it is accessible to allcomers, and we pride ourselves in being the only organization that offers the complete Argentine fishing experience, from the world's hardest fighting predator, to the world's largest purely freshwater fish, monster catfish, and the world's largest Chinook Salmon and Rainbow Trout.

For 2023/24 (May to October), we are offering an extensive and varied programme for Adventure Anglers in Argentina. All major species are covered, and you can look forward to a high standard of accommodation and meals. Conditions vary from laid back river locations to tough impenetrable country. At each of these locations we will guide you to the trophy fish of your choice.

Our fishing trips include:

- Transfers to and from airport closest to location (International Flight not Included)
- Comfortable accommodation and all meals (together with local soft drinks and alcohol)
- Services of trained guides, with comfortable, well equipped, boats. All fishing tackle and baits
 provided where needed, together with snacks and drinks onboard the boat. We operate strictly
 catch and release
- Fishing Permits
- All internal surface travel
- Assistance with translation and personal needs
- Fishing hours will be dependent on species targeted and weather conditions, but can include night fishing
- All clients are responsible for and must be in possession of valid travel insurance
- We should be informed beforehand of any special dietary requirements or medical conditions
- All our trips are accompanied by myself, with more than forty years South American experience, or tri-lingual Brit, Stephen Roche, with more than thirty years, who will ensure that, as well as a, hassle free, fishing adventure, you will be able to take full advantage of the cultural pleasures that Argentina has to offer.

GIANT SURUBI and TROPHY DORADO

Flowing through a sparsely populated area of Northern Argentina, the Rio Bermejo flows into the Rio Paraguay, and ultimately into the Rio Parana. This area is known as the Impenetrable Chaco, due to a preponderance of dense, thorny, scrub, and is home to a wide variety of wildlife.

Accommodation will be in a comfortable tented camp, next to the Impenetrable Chaco National Park, where the Tompkins Foundation is sponsoring an ambitious re-wilding program. Currently efforts are being made to re-establish Jaguar, Giant Armadillo, Chaco Peccary, and the Chaco Tortoise. Regular sightings of endangered wildlife are made in this area.

The river itself is notable for a large fish population, with trophy sized fish caught on a regular basis. This is true Adventure Fishing, with very little infrastructure. Meals will be provided by our chef from an Asado (Argentine pit barbeque), and the beer will be cold.





Transfers and Schedule

Day 1 – Arrive at Salta International Airport, where you will be met and transferred by road to your lodge, for an overnight stay in very comfortable surroundings.

Day 2 – Today you will be transferred to our remote camp in the Chaco.

Day 3 to Day 9 – For the next seven days we will fish for Surubi catfish and Dorado. We will be fishing in a stretch of river notable for large Surubi. Fish up to 50 kgs are regularly caught, and sometimes over 70 kgs. There is also a good population of Dorado to 20 kgs, and you may be lucky enough to hook into a giant Manguruyu. Our boats are well equipped, with knowledgeable guides.

Day 10 – Today we will return to Salta for your flight home.
